5. He resurrected on the third day – Luke 24: 1-6, Mark 16: 1-14, 1 Corinthians 15: 4, 20
6. He has ascended (gone) to heaven to be with the Father and also prepare a place for us in Heaven, His Father's house. As he came to earth to prepare us, He has gone back to heaven to prepare a place for us so that one day we will be with Him again – Acts 1: 9-11, John 14: 1-3
7. He has given His Holy Spirit to help, guide and comfort us while we remain here on earth, awaiting His return. He has given us His Holy Spirit so we can be His hands, mouth, feet here and continue the work He started – Matthew 3: 11, Acts 2: 29-33
8. He is the one who is going to come again to take us home. This is a temporary home for us. We are here for a season and in His time, He will come and take us home, where we will live with Him and the Father – John 14: 1-3

So, in this season of celebrating Jesus birth, the Father wants to remind us that He is coming back again and the time for that is drawing really near. Let's be prepared for His coming, and let's go out and make Him known to others.

We will like to take this opportunity to pray that you and all yours have a wonderful, peaceful and joyous Christmas, and an amazing glorious New Year 2018. May God bless you and your family abundantly in Jesus name.

PARENTING ON YOUR OWN

Isaiah 54 vs 5

For your Maker is your husband, The Lord of hosts is His name; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth. For the Lord has called you Like a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, Like a youthful wife when you were refused, "Says your God. "For a mere moment I have forsaken you, But with great mercies I will gather you. With a little wrath I hid my face from you for a moment; But with everlasting kindness I will have mercy on you," Says the Lord, your Redeemer.

God's original plan was for a husband and wife, a father and mother, to bear children and raise them together. For different reasons and circumstances though, even from Bible days men and women have had to bring up children on their own as single parents. A single Parent is one who is saddled with the responsibility of training her children all alone. The situation might have been brought about through pre-marital pregnancy, divorce, abandonment by husband, rape, widowhood etc. A situation that has happened by chance not necessarily by choice.

If you are a single parent, you are not alone. Even in Bible days men and women had to bring up children on their own for various reasons.

1. People like Lot after his wife became a pillar of salt. – Genesis 19 vs 26 and 30. Lot struggled in parenting his children. You will not struggle in Jesus name. You will overcome.
2. Hagar with her son Ishmael after Abraham sent her away. Genesis 21 vs 9 – 21
3. Jephthah's Mother – Judges 11 vs 1-11
4. The widow of Zarephath 1 Kings 17 vs 10-24
5. The late wife of one of the sons of the prophets 2 Kings 4 vs 1-7

Most of these were successful in their single parenting. You will succeed in Jesus name.

The key is to trust God to help you in this responsibility of parenthood. What should be handled by 2 parents can successfully be handled by one with the help of God. That will be your story in Jesus name.



A first step is to ask for God's help and strength to do away with sorrowing and regret. No child is an accidental child as far as God is concerned. Every single parent needs to key into God's abundance by totally surrendering their life to Christ. Total reliance on Him who is the helper of the helpless and father of the fatherless is the solution to the multi-faceted problems that sometimes accompany this situation. Let the Word of God be your friend, let the Word of God quicken and comfort and strengthen you.

There are times you may wonder and ask why you should be so unfortunate or why single parenting should be your lot. When it is difficult to understand, especially when the situation cannot be traced to your own negligence or fault, let the comfort of the Lord be the delight of your soul (Psalm 94 vs 19)

In the multitude of my anxieties within me, Your comforts delight my soul.

Even if you have ignorantly or misguidedly contributed to the situation, all you need is the mercy of our loving and forgiving God. He alone understands. Understandably, the situation can be very trying, especially when the child or children are young. A lot is expected financially, morally, socially and spiritually. Don't worry. The Lord is able. The Joy of the Lord will be your strength.

It is also very important that the church family support single parents but you as the single parent must be prepared to accept the help and support. That is one of the reasons you have been placed in the family of God (local church).

◆ Christmas Hampers Project 2017:



Yet for another year running, we as WOL want to continue to spread the practical love of Jesus Christ in our community. For a number of years now we have reached out in the spirit of goodwill to the people in the Lewisham borough, and others in our midst who could do with a little help. We have donated meal hampers to vulnerable and low-income individuals and families, and others who find Christmas a difficult period financially.

Financial hardship and difficulty, and even poverty is a reality for some in Great Britain. Our Christianity calls us to share, and help others who might be less fortunate than we are.

Each hamper we give out contains everything that an average family of 4 requires for a lovely Christmas meal. The items include a good-sized **turkey, stuffing, gravy, potatoes, carrots, sprouts, cranberry sauce, peanuts, mince pies, Christmas pudding, custard, and a bottle of sparkling non-alcoholic wine (12 items).**

This initiative has so far been made possible over the years by your generous donations. We are very thankful for that. Last year we donated 100 hampers to individuals and families in the Lewisham Borough. This year we want to do the same again and give 100 hampers away.

So, we are calling on you WOL family help make this happen by giving financially towards this. The total budget to cover this project is £2,500.

So it was, that while they were there, the days were completed for her to be delivered. And she brought forth her firstborn Son, and wrapped Him in swaddling cloths, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn.

And behold, an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were greatly afraid. ◆◆ Corporate Prayer & Fasting Guidelines

1. Please fast from food from **1st – 14th December 2017**
2. Fasting is from 6am to 6pm daily.
3. For pregnant and nursing mothers - you are not required to participate in the fast.
4. For those on medication or with an ongoing medical condition - please follow medical advice from your doctor before participating in the fast.
5. Meditate on scriptures as per prayer and fasting calendar each day, and pray based on prayer points given.
6. Use this as a time of seeking God in a deeper way – in the Word, Prayer, Worship etc
7. Choose to engage in acts of kindness and generosity to the poor and needy during this period of prayer and fasting according to Isaiah 58: 6-12.
8. Make every effort to attend the Wednesday mid -week services / join the early morning Zoom prayer meeting during this period for us to pray together as a church.

I pray that the LORD will give you strength and fill you with his joy during this time. I pray that you will encounter Him as you faithfully wait upon Him in Jesus name Amen.

THEME: FRUITFULNESS AND BREAKTHROUGH

Ezekiel 47:12 - Fruit trees of all kinds will grow on both banks of the river. Their leaves will not wither, nor will their fruit fail. Every month they will bear fruit, because the water from the sanctuary flows to them. Their fruit will serve for food and their leaves for healing.

Revelation 22:1-2 - And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.
