NOAH FINDS GRACE WITH GOD

I have over time been looking at the word GRACE in the Bible and discovered that the word GRACE has been mentioned almost 145 times in the Bible. 21 times in the Old Testament, and 124 times in the New Testament.

This word is first mentioned in Genesis 6:8 where we are told: "Noah finds favour in the eyes of the Lord." In some other translations, Genesis 6:8 says: "But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord."

The context in which this statement is based is in the earlier verses that tell us the Lord was grieved with mankind that He created. Genesis 6, "Then the Lord saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And the Lord was sorry that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. So the Lord said, "I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them."

Because of man's sin and man's rebellion God said that he will wipe both humankind and animals from the face of the earth, that is completely destroy them, because of his anger at their rebellion.

In verse 8 Noah is described as having found favor (GRACE) with God. We see from this scripture that Noah finding grace with God had nothing to do with Noah. The Bible tells us that God was sorry that he had made man and regretted making man. Noah was part of God's creation. From this scripture, we can see that the whole concepts of election, salvation, mercy, and forgiveness are all linked in this first illustration of grace in the Old Testament to one man and his family (NOAH).

I have over the years come to learn what it means to be graced and empowered. Many preachers have preached and elaborated on grace from the stand point of "no longer under the law but under grace". If we focus only on that, as true as that may be we will miss the big picture of what grace is all about.

Two things to note:

1. We are saved by grace not by works

Ephesians 2:8 "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God." The Bible makes it clear that grace is a gift from God. No one can argue or debate that.

2. We are empowered by grace

2 Corinthians 12:9 "And He said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness." Therefore, most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me."

Acts 20:32 - "And now I commend you to God and to the Word of His grace, which

is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified."

We are saved by grace and we are empowered by grace to live for God. Every believer has this favour from God and it has nothing to do with how good we are, but His Grace.

MOSES AND GOD'S PRESENCE - Exodus 33

When Moses said to God if I have found grace in your sight then let your presence go with us, he also said so we can find grace in your sight.

As I pondered on this statement by Moses, I began to see and understand where Moses was coming from. Moses in essence was saying "Lord I have been saved by grace and as we go on this journey, we will need your grace to complete this journey that we are on, for it is your grace that makes the difference." "Lord leading this people has nothing to do with how good I have been, it has nothing to do with how clever or intelligent I am. Leading this great people of yours has nothing to do with my education. I am a murderer, I have messed things up, yet you chose me, you empowered me by your grace, please do not let me down now."

People of God, our walk with God has nothing to do with the strength of our faith, it is God's faithfulness that is extended to us through His grace.

To forgive someone who has molested you, is by His Grace.

To love the unlovable, is by the grace of God.

To walk away from sin, is by the grace of God.

To live a life of holiness, is by the grace of God.

We are saved by grace through faith not by works lest any man should boast, the Bible tells us. So when Paul boasted, he boasted in his challenges not in what he had achieved, because he realized that whatever he may have achieved has been by the grace of God.

There have been times when I have questioned God's Word. There have been times when I almost blew it but by the grace of God I am still standing.

Grace is God's empowerment, Grace is God's unmerited favor, Grace is God's ability working through us, to fulfil His commission.

So when Paul cried to God three times and God responded three times "my grace is sufficient for you", God was saying to him and to us you need me more than you know it. I am the one that strengthens you and my grace is all you need in this walk of faith.

NOAH AND THE ARK

Finally, have you ever wondered how Noah could build an Ark that size?

How did he manage to bring the animals in, how did he cope with the smell?

How did he clean the ark? How did he survive 120 days in the confinement of the ark? It was all by the grace of God because he found favor with God.

Trust and rely on the grace of God alone and the grace of God will be sufficient for you. When you are weak, He will be strong in every situation and at all times!

Evidence for God:

- 1. The Bible's existence... The Bible is the Word of God and even if we don't open the Bible, it helps support the existence of God by the fact that it was written over years by 40 authors and yet is incredibly consistent from start to end. Inside its pages it contains hundreds of prophecies (predictions) that have come true not just in part but completely and precisely true! But even if we don't open the Bible, the fact that this book was written for us points towards a loving God who passionately cares about us. Did you know that if we just take some of the predictions about Jesus that came true, the likelihood they could have just 'happened' is beyond what science calls impossible!
- 2. The fact that Christians exist... Many people have tried to destroy the Bible and kill off Christians. In fact, more Christians are killed across the world today than ever before. At least 165,000 Christians are killed each year. Many countries have tried to ban the Bible. Islamic countries like Iran and Indonesia ban Christianity and the Bible; secular states like China and North Korea do the same. Yet in all those countries Christianity is growing at an incredible rate!
- 3. The life of Jesus... Only those who are mad in the head deny that Jesus was a real person. There are accurate records of him in the Bible. But there are also records of the life of Jesus from Jewish historians and people who hates him and Christians! Was he the son of God as he claimed to be? Well, Christians believe he was. If he wasn't he was obviously mad! But you cannot deny his actual existence. The Bible tells us that Jesus was God in human flesh. So if you want to know what God looks like, take a look at the life of Jesus! If you just look at the things that were foretold about Jesus hundreds of years before his birth and that the way he fulfilled them exactly, you should be convinced!
- 4. Science and archaeology... A recent scientific programme aired on television showed how over a million Israelites could have easily crossed the Red Sea, as the Bible tells us they did. Many pieces of archaeology support the truth about the life of Jesus. Even some scientists who don't believe in God will say that the evidence in science and in the ground all points to the complete accuracy of the Bible.
- 5. Creation and our consciences (that little voice inside you that tells you about right and wrong)... Romans 1.18-20 tells us that God has shown himself to mankind very plainly in their inner consciousness. It also tells us that ever since the creation of the world, God's characteristics (of being God, eternal and powerful) have been shown

in creation in ways that everyone can see and understand! Do you ever feel something inside you asking whether your life is all there is? Do you long to do something bigger than yourself, to make a difference? That is the voice of God calling you.

- 6. The created world... When you look at the intricate and incredible way that leaves are formed; the amazing range of animal, plant and bird life; the amazing way the human body works; the fact that the earth is so finely balanced that anything other than the exact way the earth works means we couldn't live... All of this points to an incredible creator. This world cannot have been formed by chance. To have done so is beyond what science calls scientifically impossible. So it is impossible this world just magic'd itself into existence. So to have such an incredible world shows there must be a powerful outside force that made and handcrafted the world and everything in it. There is God!
- 7. The life-changing story of Christians... I know of hundreds of Christians. Each one has met with God and has a personal story that is amazing. Just average everyday people have been touched by God and gone on to feed thousands; end slavery; reform prisons; go into the darkest parts of the earth and see change brought; brought hope to the hopeless; seen amazing miracles. I know of people who were gang leaders, killers, murderers, drug addicts, prostitutes all have had their lives completely changed. No other power on earth can do this except the power of God. My life has been totally changed round by God turned right way up. No-one can deny this. No-one can deny the evidence of changed lives. You may doubt it was God who did this. But if you look closely at the lives of Christians, you'll see ordinary people doing extraordinary things.

FWM Ladies Mentoring Programme

Ladies, this is introducing to you the Word of Life, Fresh Women's Ministry Ladies Mentoring Programme. This programme has at its heart a vision to see women mentored on a one to one basis, so they are developed into godly women after God's heart, fulfilling His plan,

purpose and destiny for their lives.

It is modelled after the Naomi and Ruth relationship in the Bible and open to all ladies in Word of Life Church who wish to participate in it.

Guidelines and a simple application form are available to be completed by those who want a mentor assigned to them. Please ask your cell leader or the stewards for a copy today, complete and return to us.

Based on availability, a mentor will be assigned to each lady (mentee) who seeks to be mentored. The programme will run as a year's long programme and mentoring meetings will take place once a month at agreed times and venues for a total of 12 months.

At the end of the 12 months the formal mentoring programme will finish, but the informal relationship can continue.

The Mentoring programme will seek to minister and bring development to the full man (woman) – Spirit, Soul, Body with particular attention to developing the Spirit man through the Word of God and in the power of the Holy Spirit. IT WILL SEEK TO HELP EACH LADY GET ON THE PATH OF BECOMING THE WOMAN GOD DESTINED TO BE IN THIS LIFE, AND ACTUALLY FULFIL GOD'S PURPOSE, HIGH CALLING AND DESTINY FOR THEIR LIFE.



Proposed CAP Debt Centre Opening in 2017

Christians Against Poverty (CAP) is a national organisation specialising in <u>debt counselling</u> for people in financial difficulty, including those in need of bankruptcy or insolvency. The organisation, a charity, works through a network of CAP Debt Centres all around the country that exist

in partnership with a local Christian church.

Individuals seeking the assistance of the charity give authority to the charity to negotiate with creditors, and the charity will then organise the individual's finances with the objective of making them debt free within 5 years. The caseworker will create a sustainable personal budget for clients, prioritising basic living needs and offering creditors fair, affordable pro-rata payments as far as this is possible. This service is offered at no cost to the individual.

Through the work of CAP Debt Centres many around the country have been delivered from the tyranny of debt and most importantly come to a personal relationship with Jesus as Lord and Savior.

We plan to partner with CAP and open a new CAP Debt Centre based in Rehoboth Building Grove Park that will serve the Lewisham Borough community. Proposed opening date is summer 2017. We believe God is leading us to do this and ask as a church that you please PRAY in faith to see this vision materialise. Thank you as you do so.

SUNDAY SERVICE MESSAGES


CDs of the Sunday preaching / teaching messages are available for sale each Sunday after the service at a price of £2.00 per copy.
