





SOS EVANGELISM

We are excited to announce that the WOL SOS Evangelism outreach will be starting again as we seek to continue to be a witness to those who are yet to come to know Jesus.

For those who are wondering, SOS stands for Save One Soul. We believe that we should all personally be reaching out and seeking to win one soul at a time. Once we win one soul to the Lord, then we go on to the next soul.

We as a local Church exist to win souls and make disciples. This is why we as a Church must come together and engage in corporate Church Evangelism.

So, going forward in this post lockdown period the Church will start having a weekly SOS Evangelism outreach. It will take place on Saturdays with a team going out into the community and its environs to witness and reach out with the gospel. This regular outreach will be from 11.15am to 12.15pm every Saturday, with prayer before hand in Rehoboth building from 10:30am -11:00am. This would be open to anyone who would like to join.

The plan is that the SOS Evangelism outreach would rotate between:

- Week 1- Door knocking locally
- Week 2- Street evangelism involving a portable speaker playing praise and worship while witnessing is going on. This will possibly also involve a mic for sharing testimonies etc.

In addition, each cell group will also be put on a rota as done before to be part of the outreach once a month, with the cell members joining in.

♦ POST LOCKDOWN WORSHIP AT WORD OF LIFE CHURCH, REHOBOTH BUILDING

Rehoboth Building is open to the whole WOL family, the community and the general public. The building is OPEN for our regular Sunday and Wednesday services, the Foodbank, the Youth Hub, our Children and Youth programmes and much more.

The government as you are aware has recently lifted all restrictions and now recommends a cautious approach as a result of the new Covid variants. With that in mind please note the following:

- (1) Actions the CHURCH LEADERSHIP is taking to continue to ensure your safety and the.
- (2) Actions we encourage YOU to take to ensure the collective safety of everyone

What We Are Doing

- (1) Facilitating the registration (via the church website) of attendees to the church services.
- (2) Check-in upon arrival, to aid contact tracing
- (3) Cleaning of shared areas and surfaces
- (4) Opening windows and main doors for ventilation purpose
- (5) Adjusted seating to enable some physical distancing.
- (6) Slightly reduced length of singing time. Separate designated microphones provided per each user (Singers and Speakers during each service)
- (7) Provision of individual packaged communion emblems for all
- (8) Hand Sanitiser stations placed at the Entry Point and Exit points.
- (9) Still not able to join us in person due to having to self-isolate, sickness, old age or other reasons? Online services continue to hold.

What We Encourage You To Do

- (1) To please continue to register yourself & members of your family to attend inperson services & check-in with the stewards/ushers upon arrival. You can register via the church website: www.wordoflife-lcc.org for each service you wish to attend
- (2) To please use the hand sanitisers provided
- (3) The stewards are there to help. Please follow their instructions
- (4) Family members are encouraged to please sit together (except during the time that the children & youth go to the lower hall for the Children's church & Youth connect group)
- (5) We encourage that you proceed with caution in handshaking and hugging
- (6) Please use the main front doors for entry and for exit. The stewards will be on hand to help and guide you
- (7) Please come with, and wear a mask during your time in Rehoboth Building.

We appreciate your patience and co-operation. We trust that you will understand and embrace these revised procedures as we enjoy the new freedoms after such a long time of national lockdown.

GOD's Purpose: Peace and life God loves you and wants you to experience peace and life: abundant and eternal.

"we have peace with GOD through our Lord JESUS CHRIST." (Romans 5:1)

"I have come that they may have life in abundance." (John 10:10)



"for GOD so loved the world that he gave his only begotten SON, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

Why don't most people have this peace and abundant life that God planned for us to have?

The Problem: Our Separation God created us in his own image to have an abundant life. He did not make us as robots to automatically love and obey him. God gave us a will and a freedom of choice. We chose to disobey God and go our own wilful way. We still make this choice today. This results in separation from God.

Our attempts to reach GOD People have tried many ways to bridge this gap between themselves and God....

No bridge reaches GOD... except one...

GOD's Bridge: The Cross Jesus died on the cross and rose from the grave. He paid the penalty for our sin and bridged the gap between God and people.

for Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring GOD and men, that man you to GOD." (1 Peter 3:18)

"for there is one GOD and one mediator between JESUS CHRIST." (1 Timothy 2:5)

"but GOD demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, CHRIST died (Romans 5:8)

Our Response: Receive CHRIST We must trust Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour and receive him by personal invitation.

Where are you? Will you receive JESUS CHRIST right now?


Here is how you can receive Christ:
