PRAYER BIRTHED OUT OF RELATIONSHIP

Luke 11:1

1 Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, that one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples."

Most Christians believe that prayer is just asking from God. Some of us pray out of duty. Some just because they feel it is the right thing to do. Some pray only when there is a need or a challenging situation. On the whole, many pray without realising that prayer should be an overflow from our intimate close relationship with the creator of the universe.

When Jesus' disciples saw the way Jesus prayed, they were fascinated, they were intrigued. His prayer life was birthed out of a strong and close relationship with His Father. They must have discussed this amongst themselves yet did not know how to approach Jesus. Fortunately, one of them was bold enough to approach Jesus and say-

"Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples."

Jesus began by introducing his disciples to God as a father, ***"Our Father in heaven,"*** Not just a father to one person but a Father to all. God is to be approached confidently as a caring, loving father in the context of intimacy. Through Jesus we have access to our Father in heaven

Ephesians 3:12 tells us:

In Him and through faith in Him we may enter God's presence with boldness and confidence.

When we begin to fully understand God as our Father in heaven, it would change the way we pray. Our God and heavenly Father is concerned and interested in our well-being. Other religions see their gods as alienated from their subjects. Yet it is not the same with our God. Christianity is the one faith that is built on relationship, so our prayer life should be an extension of that relationship

Paul continues his discourse in Ephesians 3:14

For this reason, I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, 15 from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

Here Paul gives us an insight to the relationship that is between us and God, the Father. We can approach Him with boldness because we are His children, we belong to the family of God.

Jesus also illustrates prayer in the context of friendship, in Luke 11:5-6

5 And He said to them, "Which of you shall have a friend, and go to him at midnight and say to him, 'Friend, lend me three loaves; 6 for a friend of mine has come to me on his journey, and I have nothing to set before him';

Jesus in John 15 says I no longer call you servants but friends. Jesus was emphasising the relationship we have with Him. Being His friends we are able to approach Him at any time.

In this discourse we are also introduced to prayer being a dialogue and not a monologue. It is clear from this scripture that friends do speak to one another. God wants to speak to us in this intimate relationship as we speak to Him.

Jesus further illustrates prayer based on a father-son relationship, in Luke 11:11

11 If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? 12 Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? 13 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"

Jesus continues in this illustration to identify God as a good father who will give His children good gifts.

If you have prayed in the past just out of duty, need, guilt or because it is the right thing to do. I want to encourage you today move to a higher level of praying out of relationship with your loving Father. Come to Him confidently without any form of slavish fear. He is your father and wants to have a dialogue with you. He wants to share His heart with you.

◆ Christmas Hamper Project

Yet for another year running, we as WOL want to continue to spread the practical love of Jesus Christ in our community. For a number of years now we have reached out in the spirit of goodwill to the people in the Lewisham borough, and others in our midst who could do with a little help. We have donated meal hampers to vulnerable and low-income individuals and families, and others who find Christmas a difficult period financially. Our Christianity calls us to share, and help others who might be less fortunate than we are.

Each hamper we give out contains everything that an average family of 4 requires for a lovely Christmas meal. The items include a good-sized turkey, stuffing, gravy, potatoes, carrots, sprouts, cranberry sauce, peanuts, mince pies, Christmas pudding, custard, and a bottle of sparkling non-alcoholic wine (12 items).

Church News - - - - -

This initiative has so far been made possible over the years by your generous donations. We are very thankful for that. Last year we donated 100 hampers to individuals and families in the Lewisham Borough. This year we want to do the same again and give 100 hampers away.

This year our target is £2,500. This will help cover the cost of 100 Christmas hampers which will help feed over 400 individuals at Christmas and also put the gospel message in their hands. A donation of £25 will help purchase a Christmas Hamper for a family of 4 plus a DVD Containing the gospel message.

A donation of £100 will purchase 4 hampers that will feed at least 16 individuals.

A donation of £200 will purchase 8 hampers that will feed at least 32 individuals.

So, we are calling on you WOL family to be a part of this and help meet the target in the following ways:

1. We ask that each one put this on your gift list and see it as you getting a present for a family in need.
2. Each person sponsor the purchase of at least one hamper by donating £25 or more. We are looking for even the children where possible to reach out to the needy by also contributing. Parents, you can help them out.....
3. Encourage your family, friends, and colleagues to donate towards this project. They can donate online via the Church's website (reference: Christmas Hampers 2016)
4. Please pray that we will meet the target of £2,500.

Corporate Prayer & Fasting Diary - - -

1st to 14th DECEMBER 2018

THEME: WAGE A GOOD WARFARE

1 Timothy 1: 18

18 This charge I commit to you, son Timothy, according to the prophecies previously made concerning you, that by them you may wage the good warfare, 19 having faith and a good conscience, which some having rejected, concerning the faith have suffered shipwreck

A lot of God given prophecies and prophetic utterances have been released over us as WOL in the past years, and in particular this year too. When God speaks, His Words do not fall to the ground. Over this 14 days we are going to be seeking the Lord in fasting, praying and waging a good warfare to see God's plan fulfilled in 2019.

SATURDAY 1ST OF DECEMBER

2 Chronicles 7:14 and Jeremiah 29:12-14

if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land."

Let today be a day of consecration to the Lord

Today let us spend time in prayer, pouring our heart out to the Lord. As a Church, let us humble ourselves before Him, let us tell Him of areas where we have sinned against Him and ask for forgiveness. Let us ask God for His mercy. Let us cry out to the Lord today for mercy over Grove Park, Mercy over our Land. Let us cry out to God for mercy over us as a Church for the lack of unity, for the complaining and the murmuring against one another. Let us cry out to God today, that we truly want to see His face. Let us pray that God will heal our land in 2019 and move us forward to greater heights in Jesus name.

SUNDAY 2ND OF DECEMBER

2 Corinthians 6:1, 2 Corinthians 8:1, 2 Corinthians 8:6 and 2 Corinthians 12:9

Today as God's co-workers let us pray that we will walk in God's grace and that we will not receive His grace in vain. Let us pray that we will have a knowledge of God's grace in abundance. Pray that in 2019 as a church and as individuals we will rely on His grace. Let us therefore today bring to Him our challenges, our disappointments, our complacency. Let today be a day when we pour our hearts to God. Our pains, our struggles, our fears, etc.

MONDAY 3RD OF DECEMBER

Psalms 65:11-13 and Jeremiah 29:11

Let us pray today into 2019. Let us pray that the Lord will crown the year 2019 with His goodness and favour. Let us pray that our paths will drip with abundance. Let us pray for God's abundance in every area of the Church's life. **DECLARATION:** We declare, "For we know the plans God has for us, plans to prosper us and not to harm us, plans to give us hope and a future. God has great plans for us. God will prosper us in the morning, He will prosper us in the afternoon and in the evening. Today by the authority we have in Jesus, we declare God's abundance in every sphere of WOL. Abundance in His anointing, abundance of joy, abundance of favour, abundance in our finance.

TUESDAY 4TH OF DECEMBER

Exodus 11:3, 1 Samuel 2:26, Isaiah 61:1-2 and Acts 2:47

Let us pray today for God's favour in 2019

The Bible says the boy Samuel continued to grow in stature and in favour with the Lord and with people. Let us pray that WOL will continue to grow in favour with the Lord and the people. Pray that just like the early disciples found favour with the people and the Lord added unto them daily those who were being saved. Pray that the Lord will be add unto us on a daily basis those who are being saved in Jesus name.

DECLARATION: We declare that the Lord will make the people favourably disposed towards us, and WOL will be highly regarded in the Borough of Lewisham by its officials and by the people. Because the Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on us, the Lord has anointed us to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent us to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release the prisoners from darkness, we therefore declare and proclaim 2019 the year of the Lord's favour and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in WOL to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair. WOL will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the Lord for the display of his splendour in Jesus name. The Lord has favoured us and we will be favoured.



WEDNESDAY 5TH OF DECEMBER

Matthew 9:37-38, Acts 6:3 and Exodus 35:35

Jesus said to His disciples ***“The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.”***

Let us pray today for workers with the heart for God’s kingdom. Let us pray that God will bring workers who have the same vision God has given to WOL. Workers who are full of the Spirit and wisdom. Let us pray for workers who will be diligent in their service to the Lord. Let us pray today for workers whom God has given skills to do all kinds of work as the need arises.

DECLARATION: Lord we thank you for skilled workers and designers. We thank you for ministers, pastors, evangelists, prophets, teachers and apostles from the North, South, East and the West. We call them forth in the name of Jesus. We call forth musicians, singers, ushers, children workers, youth workers, technical and multi-media workers, hospitality and event workers, protocol workers, PAs, cell leaders. We declare today that these ones would be favourably disposed to WOL in Jesus name.

THURSDAY 6TH OF DECEMBER

Ephesians 4, Psalm 133 :1, John 17:23 and 2 Chronicles 30:12

Today we are praying for unity and maturity in WOL. Let us pray that in WOL we will live a life that is worthy of the calling we have received. Pray that as individuals and as a Church we will be completely humble and gentle, we will be patient, bearing with one another in love and that we will make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

DECLARATION: Let us declare today that it is good and pleasant when God’s people live together in unity! Jesus in us and we abiding in Him, we are in complete unity. We declare today that as a Church we are united, stand firm in the Lord. We declare today that the hand of God is on us to give us unity of mind to carry out what we have been called to Grove Park to do by following the word of the Lord. We therefore declare God’s blessing over WOL. For the word of God says, where there is unity, there the Lord has commanded His blessings and live forever more. WOL you are blessed and highly favoured.

FRIDAY 7TH OF DECEMBER

Acts 10:38, Psalm 110:3, Isaiah 10:27 and Hebrews 1:9

Today we are going to pray for God’s anointing over every ministry represented in WOL. Let us pray that just as God anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit and Power every ministry leader, every cell leader, every worker, will be anointed in Jesus name. The Bible says in the days of His power the people will be willing, let us pray for God’s anointing over every service, every event. Let us pray according to Isaiah 10:27 that yokes will be broken and burdens removed because of the anointing of God over us as a Church.
