#### ♦ I am ANDREW

#### Who is Andrew?

Andrew was one of the first disciples Jesus called during His earthly ministry. The first chapter of John's gospel recounts how Andrew learnt who Jesus was – and then immediately found his brother, Simon Peter, and brought him to meet the Son of God. Today, you can do the same by praying for family members, friends, neighbours, and co-workers who don't know Jesus and then bring them to hear the gospel.

We are partnering with the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association (BGEA) next year to spread the gospel and win souls for the Lord. To this effect we are introducing "I am ANDREW" in which we ask you to introduce a friend to Christ. Next year we will be hosting "I am ANDREW" Sundays & ask you to prepare to do 4 things:

1. Pray - write down the name of at least one person who needs Jesus and pray each day for them

- 2. Bring Bring them to the evangelistic event that will be taking place at the O2 arena next year 4th October 2020
- 3. Share Spend time with them to deepen friendship
- 4. Follow up Invite them to WOL church with you

We will be a host for the Borough of Lewisham for the BGEA Christian Life and Witness course in April / May 2020 . Here you, and others will learn how to share your faith effectively and verbally present the gospel - Topics include *The Effective Christian Life, The Christian Witness, and How to Follow-up and Disciple New Believers.* More information and details will be communicated on an ongoing basis. Please look out for this.

### Church Services & Meetings

This is an encouragement to all you WOL members about regular attendance. The Bible in the book of Hebrews encourages us to not forsake the coming together, or the gathering together of Christian believers as we see the day of the Lord (His return) approach.

We want to admonish you to please give utmost priority to your attendance at church services, church meetings, cell group meetings etc. Let's come together for teaching, fellowship, exhortation, admonition, discipleship and much more. #### Christmas Hampers

Christmas is around the corner and as a church we are looking again to be a blessing to our community / borough by giving out Christmas hampers to the needy and poor, not forgetting those in our midst that might need that help.

Each hamper will have everything that an average family of 4 requires for a lovely Christmas meal. The items include a good sized turkey, stuffing, gravy, potatoes, carrots, sprouts, cranberry sauce, peanuts, mince pies, Christmas pudding, custard, and a bottle of sparkling non-alcoholic wine (12 items).

This year our target is £2,500. This will help cover the cost of 100 Christmas hampers which will help feed over 400 individuals at Christmas & also put the gospel mes-

sage in their hands. A donation of £25 will help purchase a Christmas Hamper for a family of 4 plus material containing the gospel message. To do this we need your support in giving towards this initiative. We encourage you to give generously. A donation of £25 will provide a hamper for a family of 4 to 5.

#### ♦ Hall for Hire

Rehoboth building is available for use at various times throughout the week and open to the community for multiple purposes. The Resource Centre (lower floor) is made up of a multi-function hall, as well as a kitchen/chill out room, a medium sized room and a large entrance/hallway. These can be used for seminars, workshops, training days, product launches, baby showers, private dinners, extra tuition classes, small events etc... The multi-function hall is suitable for a maximum of approximately 80 people with a cabaret style seating arrangement, 100 people with theatre style seating arrangement or 120 people standing.

The main hall in Rehoboth Building is also open for use to members of the community. It has a capacity of approximately 180 seats. However, its use is reserved exclusively for church services, including weddings, funerals or child dedication services. # SCRIPTURES OF THE MONTH

Matthew 20: 20 - 28 (NKJV) 20 Then the mother of Zebedee's sons came to Him with her sons, kneeling down and asking something from Him. 21 And He said to her, "What do you wish?" She said to Him, "Grant that these two sons of mine may sit, one on Your right hand and the other on the left, in Your kingdom."

22 But Jesus answered and said, "You do not know what you ask. Are you able to drink the cup that I am about to drink, [a]and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with?" They said to Him, "We are able." 23 So He said to them, "You will indeed drink My cup, [b]and be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with; but to sit on My right hand and on My left is not Mine to give, but it is for those for whom it is prepared by My Father." 24 And when the ten heard it, they were greatly displeased with the two brothers. 25 But Jesus called them to Himself and said, "You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those who are great exercise authority over them. 26 Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. 27 And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave— 28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

**Mark 10: 43 - 45 (NKJV)** <sup>43</sup> Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant. <sup>44</sup> And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all. <sup>45</sup> For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

**Luke 22: 24 - 27 (NKJV)**<sup>24</sup> Now there was also a dispute among them, as to which of them should be considered the greatest. <sup>25</sup> And He said to them, "The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them, and those who exercise authority over them are called 'benefactors.' <sup>26</sup> But not so among you; on the contrary, he who is greatest among you, let him be as the younger, and he who governs as he who serves. <sup>27</sup> For who is greater, he who sits at the table, or he who serves? Is it not he who sits at the table? Yet I am among you as the One who serves.

**John 13: 5 - 17** (NKJV) <sup>5</sup> After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. <sup>6</sup> Then He came to Simon Peter. And Peter said to Him, "Lord, are You washing my feet?" <sup>7</sup> Jesus answered and said to him, "What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this." <sup>8</sup> Peter said to Him, "You shall never wash my feet!" Jesus answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me." <sup>9</sup> Simon Peter said to Him, "Lord, not my feet only, but also my hands and my head!" <sup>10</sup> Jesus said to him, "He who is bathed needs only to wash his feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you." <sup>11</sup> For He knew who would betray Him; therefore He said, "You are not all clean." <sup>12</sup> So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you <sup>[3]</sup>know what I have done to you? <sup>13</sup> You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. <sup>14</sup> If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. <sup>15</sup> For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you. <sup>16</sup> Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him. <sup>17</sup> If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.

## .....FIRST WORD ....

### THE SERVANT KING

This joyous Christmas season we celebrate the birth of our Servant King - Jesus. From the time of His birth He was declared and revealed to us to be King.

Matthew 2: 1 - 2

Now after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea in the days of Herod the king, behold, [a]wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, 2 saying, "Where is He who has been born King of the Jews? For we have seen His star in the East and have come to worship Him."

Yet this King did not come to be served and waited on. He came to serve God the Father, and to serve humanity. He came to serve you and I.

So, in Matthew 20: 27 – 28 He said:

27 And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave— 28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

He set the ultimate example of what we His followers and disciples should be like.

John 13: 5 – 7, 12 - 17

After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel with which He was girded. 6 Then He came to Simon Peter. And Peter said to Him, "Lord, are You washing my feet?"7 Jesus answered and said to him, "What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this." 12 So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you [a]know what I have done to you? 13 You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. 14 If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet. 15 For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you. 16 Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him. 17 If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.

He humbled himself and abased himself to serve God and serve us. He today calls us also to serve God, and to serve one another with humility, with great selflessness and with everything that we have.

The story of Christmas is the story of our Lord and Saviour that surrendered Himself to serve the purposes of the Father and meet the greatest need we had - that of reconciliation, forgiveness and salvation. He came to serve us!

So, let us also become servant disciples like our Servant King, serving God, serving His Kingdom, and serving others no matter what it costs us! In all your celebration this Christmas, remember that He was the Servant King that calls you and I to follow, and be like Him.

#### 1Thessalonians 5:16-18



# God Loves YOU and wants you to have a relationship with Him through His son Jesus.


The Bible says that God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, Jesus, so that whoever believes in him shall not die, but have eternal life (John 3: 16).
