TESTIMONY OF GOD'S GOODNESS

We want to acknowledge the foundation of this testimony is the importance of having confidence in God's Word and fully believing He has a plan and purpose for us, even when it feels otherwise.

Both of us have always dreamt of starting a family. Numerous unsuccessful attempts hurt us deeply. Falling short can hurt much more than not starting in the first place. The immense struggle for us was standing up each time and trying again.

After successfully conceiving again early this year, we refrained from celebrating, concerned the pattern would continue. However, we smashed our previous record and received positive news appointment after appointment; there was a heartbeat!



However, the pregnancy was not straightforward. The following scan, we learned there was a blood restriction on the cord between the placenta and the baby. This increases the probability of an underweight baby or high blood pressure for Akua. Additionally, at a later stage, the baby was in breach (wrong way round for birth). Akua was given an emergency appointment the following week by accident during the doctor's strike to painfully manually turn the baby. But praise God just before the procedure the baby turned itself!

Considering the pregnancy was "high risk" Akua was given extra appointments. At one of these, we were told the wrong location and therefore we were late. Due to this, we were informed we would not be seen and I kicked up a fuss and used my position within the hospital to pressure them into seeing us. At this appointment, it was discovered Akua had developed sudden pre-eclampsia and this diagnosis triggered a decision to induce and trigger the labour early to protect mother and baby. We think back to the miracle of James getting this job and putting him in a position to act at this time.

The induction did not go well. After multiple methods and attempts contractions started and increased in frequency. However, after each cluster of contractions, the baby's heartbeat would drop from 150 beats per minute to as low as 70 (half of where they should be). An immediate C-section birth was recommended and within 30 minutes we were taken into the operating room.

At 13:13 on 15th October 2023, Eden Mynott was born weighing 2.65kg!

Following this moment of absolute joy was a six-day hospital stay on top of the three days already admitted. Akua's blood pressure did not drop as in some cases of pre-eclampsia and Eden had severe jaundice. Although jaundice is common affecting around 60% of babies Eden's readings were so high she was close to being recommended a blood transfusion to avoid possible brain damage and cerebral palsy. Instead, Eden was treated with phototherapy for 24 hours which controlled the jaundice until levels started naturally reducing on their own. Combined with Akua's blood pressure stabilising we were finally discharged home.

During a home midwife follow-up, it was highlighted that Eden had alarmingly still not regained her birth weight (babies lose weight first few days), also Eden had only gained 10 grams over 4 days, well short of the 28gram per day target. We were told that Eden had to gain considerable weight over the next 3 days or be hospitalised. We attempted to force-feed Eden as often (and lovingly) as possible and by the review appointment, Eden had not only exceeded her birth weight but gained 260 grams over 4 days (almost impossible for a baby her size).

Eden and Akua are now both healthy, Akua's C-section recovery was tricky at first but she has shocked healthcare professionals at how fast she has been able to return to day-to-day life.

Our testimony is this, even when it seems like everything has gone wrong or is going wrong we should trust God. If it's his plan, nothing can derail it.

January this year after a long period of meditation in the spirit I knew it would be our year and everything we put our hand to would succeed. Since then Akua landed the best job she'd ever had, past her driving test and has a car on the way, we have purchased a house and now have a baby after recurrent miscarriages. God is faithful.

We want to thank you all for your support and prayers. Please continue to pray for us and also for yourselves! We will bring Eden up in WOL and therefore am counting on all of you as extended members of our family to be Godly influences and role models, people of wisdom and advice and saints of character and integrity showing Eden what a Bible-believing, Sprit filled church should be.

JESUS CHRIST, THE SON OF MAN, THE SON OF GOD

Luke 22:66-70

66 As soon as it was day, the elders of the people, both chief priests and scribes, came together and led Him into their council, saying, 67 "If You are the Christ, tell us." But He said to them, "If I tell you, you will by no means believe.

68 And if I also ask you, you will by no means answer Me or let Me go. 69 Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of the power of God."

70 Then they all said, <u>"Are You then the Son of God?"</u>

So, He said to them, "You rightly say that I am."
71 And they said, "What further testimony do we need? For we have heard it our-

71 And they said, "What further testimony do we need? For we have heard it ourselves from His own mouth."

I have deliberately highlighted, the following statements, for you to know without any iota of doubt, that Jesus Himself confirmed His identity as the Son of God to the World, through His answers, <u>"You rightly say that I am."</u>

Today many do not believe that Jesus is the Son of God, neither do they believe that Jesus is God.

Yes, it is difficult to believe, because to many it is foolishness, how can the creator of the whole earth have a son.

There are some religious groups who believe in Jesus, but do not believe that He was God, neither do they believe that He was His son.

There are those who believe just as Christians do that Jesus was born of a virgin, but struggle with the concept of Him being a son. Many believe He was just a prophet.

There are those who believe that Jesus was a good man, but not the Son of God.

There are those who believe that He was created just like every other human, but to be God and God's Son is incomprehensible.

Jesus consistently and constantly referred to Himself as the Son of Man.

Matthew 20:28

28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

Mark 14:62

62 Jesus said, "I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power and coming with the clouds of heaven."

Luke 19:9-10

9 And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because he

also is a son of Abraham; 10 <u>for the Son of Man</u> has come to seek and to save that which was lost."

John 3:13

13 No one has ascended to heaven but He who came down from heaven, <u>that is, the Son of Man</u> who is in heaven.

Jesus may have on numerous occasions referred to Himself as the Son of Man instead of the Son of God for a reason.

I believe it was intentional as the term sons of God has been used for many others.

When you look in the book of Job. Let us look at Job 1:6

6 Now there was a day when <u>the sons of God</u> came to present themselves before the Lord, and Satan also came among them.

Job 2:1

Again, there was a day when <u>the sons of God</u> came to present themselves before the Lord, and Satan also came among them to present himself before the Lord.

We as believers are also referred to as the sons or the children of God because of Jesus Christ.

However, when we look deeper into the scriptures, we will realise that Jesus was intentional about this title the Son of Man.

Let's look in the Old Testament.

Daniel 7:13-14

13 "I was watching in the night visions, And behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him.

If we look at Jesus' statement, we will realise that Jesus was quoting from the book of Daniel. Let us look at the similarity.

Mark 14:62

62 Jesus said, "I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power and coming with the clouds of heaven."

Luke 22:69

69 Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of the power of God."

Now let us look at the next verse in Daniel 7:14

14 Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom,
That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him.
His dominion is an everlasting dominion,

Which shall not pass away, And His kingdom the one Which shall not be destroyed.

When we come to Matthew 28:18 Jesus says, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

We hear Jesus echo the words of the vision of Daniel.

Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom,
That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him.
His dominion is an everlasting dominion,

When we listen to Jesus, we realise that Jesus was constantly and intentionally, making references to the Old Testament pointing each and everyone to Scriptures, making sure we knew He was the One scripture spoke about.

He was the One spoken about in Genesis. He was the One spoken about in the Psalms. He was the One spoken about in Isaiah.

Isaiah tells us in chapter 7:14

14 Therefore the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son and will call him Immanuel.

Immanuel, that is God with us.

In Chapter 9:6,

For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

A child was born. Who was that Child? Matthew, in Matthew 1:22-23 states: 22 So all this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet, saying: 23 "Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us."

Let us quickly take a look at what Luke wrote about the announcement of the birth of Jesus.

The angel Gabriel speaking to Mary says these words to her and I want you to take note of the prophecy of Daniel from chapter 7.

30 Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. 31 And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call <u>His name Jesus</u>. 32 He will be great and will be called the <u>Son of the Highest</u>; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. 33 And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of <u>His kingdom there will</u> be no end."

The angel repeats the same words of Daniel, which is:

Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. <u>His dominion is an</u>

everlasting dominion,

His Dominion, His Kingdom and Sovereignty will be without end, it will be everlasting.

Whilst we are at this point let us quickly take look at some of the words of John.

In John Chapter 1:1

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

In verse 14, John makes this bold statement and says.

14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

In Chapter 3:16-17

He goes on to say,

16 For God so loved the world that He gave <u>His only begotten Son,</u> that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17 For God did not send <u>His Son</u> into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

John points his reader to Jesus' identity as the only begotten and also testifies in his writing that Jesus is the only begotten of God. Who was the Word and was God and lived amongst us.

John went on to say in Chapter 20 of his writing with full confidence. This was what he said.

John 20:30-31

30 And truly Jesus did many other signs in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; 31 but these are written that you may believe that <u>Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God</u>, and that believing you may have life in His name.

I want to submit to you today that scripture unequivocally makes it clear, that Jesus is the Son of Man and also the Son of God.

His deity as the Son of Man, shows that Jesus descended from heaven into earth for a purpose and ascended into heaven after fulfilling His divine purpose here on earth.

I pray that as we celebrate Christmas, we will remember that it is more than the turkey and the presents and that Jesus the Son of Man, the Son of God, is God's gift to you today.

If you have not come to that point of repenting believing and confessing Jesus, to receive abundant life, my prayers is that like John's final statement in **John 20:31** will convince and convict you to do so.

"and that believing you may have life in His name".

"we have peace with GOD through our Lord JESUS CHRIST." (Romans 5:1)

"I have come that they may have life in abundance." (John 10:10)



"for GOD so loved the world that he gave his only begotten SON, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

Why don't most people have this peace and abundant life that God planned for us to have?

The Problem: Our Separation God created us in his own image to have an abundant life. He did not make us as robots to automatically love and obey him. God gave us a will and a freedom of choice. We chose to disobey God and go our own wilful way. We still make this choice today. This results in separation from God.
