







God Loves You


God Loves YOU and wants you to have a relationship with Him through His son Jesus.

First Word The Christian Family

By Reverend Rowland Henshaw

Some years ago, I was privileged to minister in a church in Denmark, and I remember saying to them that **Strong families make strong churches.**

There is a book titled **Connecting Church and Home by Tim Kimmel**, the author defines the family as **"the domestic church"** and defines the church as **"a gathering of domestic churches."** He goes on to say, **"Strong churches don't make strong families. Strong families make strong churches."**



What is interesting with us Pastors is that we focus more on everything else, such as the anointing, impartation, finances, but talk less about families. Once a year we organise conferences on marriage, parenting, singles, but neglect the most important aspect of what should keep the Church stronger.

God said about Abraham in Genesis 18:19

For I have known him, in order that <u>he may command his children and</u> <u>his household after him</u>, <u>that they keep the way of the Lord</u>, <u>to do right-</u> <u>eousness and justice</u>, that the Lord may bring to Abraham what He has spoken to him.

To truly understand the concept of the Christian family, you have to go back to scripture.

Before we go any further, I want to make it clear that we are looking and focussing on the Christian Family.

You might ask me why the focus on Christian family.

Because there is a difference between the concept of the Christian family and the (TRADITIONAL) secular family.

"A Christian family is a FAMILY who are related to each other through marriage, birth, or adoption and are committed, first and foremost, to

the person and work of Jesus Christ, faithfully witnessing to the love, power, and forgiveness of God."

The Christian family is a family that makes God the centre of their home.

The Christian family lives by the Word of God.

The Christian family is led by the Spirit of God.

Let us quickly look at scripture.

1 Timothy 3:16-17

16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness, 17 so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

It is very important for us to understand, that **ALL SCRIPTURE** is inspired by God.

It is therefore very important for Christian families to live and build their homes on these 4 core values.

- TEACHING
- REBUKING,
- CORRECTING
- AND TRAINING IN RIGHTEOUSNESS,

I want us to quickly take a look at two families that dates back to the 18th century. The families of Jonathan Edwards and Max Jukes.

So, what is the dictionary definition of a family?

The dictionary defines family as:

A basic social unit consisting of parents and their children, considered as a group, whether dwelling together or not: - This is referred to as the traditional family.

A social unit consisting of one or more adults together with the children

Generational Comparison Jonathan Edwards Vs. Max Jukes

- Man of God and married a woman of like character. Committed their marriage to the Lord.
- Descendants:
 - 300 clergymen
 - 100 professors
 - 100 attorneys
 - 30 judges, 1 dean of law school
 - 60 physicians, 1 dean of medical
 - 14 presidents of universities

they care for: referred to as - a single-parent family.

The children of one person or one couple collectively:

The spouse and children of one person: it could be through adoption or stepchildren.

Any group of people closely related by blood or marriage, as Grandparents, parents, children, uncles, aunts, nephews, nieces and cousins:

- the wider family

God is the originator of the family and continues to hold the copyright to it, whether we agree or disagree. God's concept of family at the beginning of humanity, is for one man and one woman to join together in a spiritually and physically committed union for a lifetime, conceiving and rearing children.

Genesis 1:27–28. 26 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our

likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." 27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God, He created him; male and female He created them.

Clearly, God's model of marriage and family wasn't followed consistently throughout the Scriptures. Neither is it followed today.

Today we have different variations of families - single parents, married couples without children, grandparents rearing their grandchildren, and empty-nesters and many more, making up a considerable percentage of "Christian" families. Whether we like it or not they are "families". When we look at some of these "families" some might not be patterned in the way God had set it in Genesis, they are still families in God's eyes.

Ephesians 3:14-15

14... for this reason I bow my knees before the Father, 15 from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. The Father from whom every family----

In the King James version

14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

Who is Paul talking about here?

The King James version makes it clearer in the sense that Paul is not talking about any earthly father, but God the Father, the creator of heaven and earth. Paul is making it clear to his listeners that family is from God not from man.

WHY FAMILY

Genesis 1:28

God blessed them and said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth and subdue it; rule over the fish of the sea and the birds of the air and every creature that crawls upon the earth."

Genesis 9:1

And God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth.

God's purpose for the family from creation was for it to be fruitful, reproduction and a channel of blessing from one generation to another, the family is meant to be the first source of spiritual training and preparation for adulthood. A place of security, love, reverence for God and an extension of God's kingdom here on earth.

IN THE BEGINNING

We can trace the origin of the family to Genesis.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

The most important aspect of creation is its origin, and the origin is God. No matter how much debate or discussion there is, it is clear from scripture that God is the creator. In His creation, we are introduced to His character and attributes. Genesis reveals God's character:

It reveals God's deepest desire to relate to man.

It reveals God's plans.

It reveals God's desire to fellowship with us.

Genesis also reveals the inception of marriage and families.

Genesis 2:18, 21-25.

18 And the Lord God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper comparable to him."

Genesis 2:21-25

21 And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs and closed up the flesh in its place. 22 Then the rib which the Lord God had taken from man He made into a woman, and He brought her to the man.

23 And Adam said: "This is now bone of my bones.

And flesh of my flesh. She shall be called Woman,

Because she was taken out of Man."

24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

25 And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

The Christian family should live their lives to honour, reverence, obey God, establish His kingdom and bring Him glory here on earth.




Bible Book of the Month

THE BOOK OF EZEKIEL

This month, let's join to read, meditate, study, and explore the book of EZEKIEL.

The book is ascribed to Ezekiel, son of Buzi, priest and prophet. He was raised in Jerusalem in a priestly family and lived with the Jews in Babylon during the exile.

The book of Ezekiel contains the prophecies, visions, and symbolic actions of Ezekiel. He was an exile prophet who lived among the exiles in Babylon. This prophetic book is filled with deeply symbolic visions and extreme actions from a man of zealous faith and profound spiritual vision. The book struggles to respond to the terrible catastrophe of the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple. It includes an awesome vision of the throne-chariot of God; prophecies of the judgment of God on Judah and Jerusalem (including the future and final fall of the city); prophecies against the nations surrounding Israel; and many symbolic actions and visions. The book concludes with visions of the future restoration of the land and the Temple, and the return of the glory of the Lord (God's presence) to Israel forever.
