




God Loves You


God Loves YOU and wants you to have a relationship with Him through His son Jesus.

GO TO THE HIGHWAYS

We must never put the benefits of the cross before HIS MISSION. Yes, the benefits are essential, but not as important as the mission

The mission must always be in the forefront of our Christianity. When Jesus rose from the dead, He gave power, He gave authority to His disciples and then commanded His disciples to **"GO"**

Matthew 28:18-20

18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 GO therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and Io, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.



Jesus' command to GO is an extension of what the father asked Jesus to do.

Jesus has laid the example of His obedience to His father and expects us His disciples to do the same.

Jesus wants us to see the lost the way He saw and still sees them, scattered and lost without direction.

Jesus wants us to have compassion for them just as He had and still has.

As believers, we do not realise, how important the lost are to God. God gave His only begotten Son that the lost might be reconciled to Him.

Luke 14:21 - 23

There is an urgency, the Master does not want us to delay. The mission is an urgent mission. The Master wants us to invite them in. He want us to do what ever it takes to bring the lost into His house.

into the streets and lanes of the city and bring in here the poor and the maimed and the lame and the blind.' 22 And the servant said, 'Master, it is done as you commanded, and still there is room.'

23 Then the master said to the servant, 'Go out into the highways and hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.

First Word

Even when we think everyone has been invited, we will realise that there is still room for more. The Master is saying my house must be filled.

We might be comfortable with empty chairs or filled chairs; however the master does not want anyone left out. He wants us to go highways, different ways, paths, options and areas, that His house, not my house, but His House may be full.

He wants us to **GO** out and compel them, He wants us to explore all possible routes and avenues, thorough which the lost can be met, so that His house might be full.

Pray that your words convey His message clearly and effectively. Pray for wisdom to discern when to speak and listen.


23rd February – 28th February

God and Government (by Sylbourne Sydial)

GOD & GOVERNMENT AND ITS RELATIONSHIP TODAY

Have you ever wondered what is the relationship between God and Government? There are various school of thoughts where it is said that politics should not mix with religion or God or vice versa that there is and should be a relationship.

Firstly, what does the bible say?

Romans 13:1 says "Let everyone be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God." This verse emphasizes that all governmental authority ultimately derives from God.

Daniel 2:21 says "He changes times and seasons; he deposes kings and raises up others. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning." This passage highlights God's sovereignty over earthly rulers and governments.

"For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God." This reiterates



the concept that God is the source of all authority, including governmental authority. "Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God [granted by His permission and sanction], and those which exist have been put in place by God." This expanded translation further clarifies that governmental authority exists by God's permission and appointment.

These scriptures collectively indicate that while human governments exist, their authority is delegated by and subordinate to God's ultimate authority. They suggest that God establishes governmental structures for specific purposes within His overall plan for humanity.

But how do we practically go about this today is it that we take our guidance from God as the best way to understand the relationship and not to separate ourselves. For instance Titus 3:1 says "Remind the people to be subject to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready to do whatever is good" this can be interpreted that we should be obedient to our Government that is obeying the laws and also to be ready to do whatever is good, this could mean getting involved in politics, counsellors, Members of Parliament to have a voice a Godly voice in the corridors of power as like Daniel, Moses and many godly examples.

This is quick snapshot on this very intriguing topic for today and food for thought and I look forward to your feedback.






This year we are continuing with the refurbishment of the building in our quest to beautify the house of the Lord that He has blessed us with.

One of the things that we want to do amongst other things is replace the chairs in the main sanctuary.

The present chairs were bought in 2016, second hand for $\pounds 1$ each from our mother church Kensington Temple, when the building was first purchased. They already had a life span of 17 years before we got them. These chairs have served us very well over the years and now is the time to replace them.

Topic: The harvest and the labourers

Bible verse: Matthew 9:37, Luke 9:1-2, John 4:35, Mark 16:15, Matthew 28:19, 2 Corinthians r 5:18, Romans 10:14,

Note

- Who is the harvest?

• The harvest refers to those who are ready to revive the gospel and salvation. People who are ready to believe.

Matthew Henry - "The multitudes desire spiritual instructions"

- Who are the Laborers
- Every believer in Christ Jesus. Every one of us.
- He doesn't want us to waste any opportunity. So, we should pray that God should send us out to God's harvest.
- If we're Christian today, we're the labourers
- God doesn't want us to perish, that's why he sent his only begotten son.
- The primary reason why we're still alive is because it's through us that the message can get to the harvest.
- Go into the all the world and preach the gospel to every creature (Mark 16:15)
- We already have the authority and the mandate to go. "He has committed to us, words of reconciliation" (2 Cor 5:18)

"Everything outside of Jesus fails"

- Who is stopping the harvest?

- We're not reaching out to them; we're not speaking to them about Jesus
- How can they call on they have not believed in? And how can they believe in one they have not heard of? And how are they to hear without someone preaching to them? (Romans 12:14)
- It's not just the pastors' job, we're all called to preach the gospel, whichever way we want (either by music, art) however it is preached, just let it be preached.
- We have to sow the seed, we have to be persistent with the preaching, (inviting them to church, sending them preachings, praying for them) that's how the harvest becomes ready
- We should understand that there will always be people that will not believe but we should not let that discourage us because they will always be people that will believe.
- Those who sow in tears shall reap in joy (Psalm 126:5)

Steps to be a laborer

- 1. Realize and accept that we're God's labourers
- 2. Understand that the harvest requires work and labour

3. Pray for the ready harvest and pray for divine opportunities to reach them

- 4. Be willing and available to God
- 5. Make it part of your life's goal (Proverbs 11: 30


How to reap harvest

- 1. By faith in God
- 2. Target your prayers (lord send me souls that are ready to be reaped)
- 3. Get involved with your unsaved neighbours, friends, colleagues). Show love, be friendly, be nice
- 4. Share your testimony of a change and transform life

- 6. Use the natural and spiritual gift God has given you.


