SCRIPTURES OF THE MONTH

1 Samuel 30: 1 - 19 (NKJV)

Now it happened, when David and his men came to Ziklag, on the third day, that the Amalekites had invaded the South and Ziklag, attacked Ziklag and burned it with fire, ² and had taken captive the women and those who were there, from small to great; they did not kill anyone, but carried them away and went their way. 3 So David and his men came to the city, and there it was, burned with fire; and their wives, their sons, and their daughters had been taken captive. 4 Then David and the people who were with him lifted up their voices and wept, until they had no more power to weep. ⁵ And David's two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the widow of Nabal the Carmelite, had been taken captive. 6 Now David was greatly distressed, for the people spoke of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was are grieved, every man for his sons and his daughters. But David strengthened himself in the LORD his God. 7 Then David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, "Please bring the ephod here to me." And Abiathar brought the ephod to David. 8 So David inquired of the LORD, saying, "Shall I pursue this troop? Shall I overtake them?" And He answered him, "Pursue, for you shall surely overtake them and without fail recover all." 9 So David went, he and the six hundred men who were with him, and came to the Brook Besor, where those stayed who were left behind. 10 But David pursued, he and four hundred men; for two hundred stayed behind, who were so weary that they could not cross the Brook Besor. 11 Then they found an Egyptian in the field, and brought him to David; and they gave him bread and he ate, and they let him drink water. 12 And they gave him a piece of a cake of figs and two clusters of raisins. So when he had eaten, his strength came back to him; for he had eaten no bread nor drunk water for three days and three nights. 13 Then David said to him, "To whom do you belong, and where are you from?" And he said, "I am a young man from Egypt, servant of an Amalekite; and my master left me behind, because three days ago I fell sick. 14 We made an invasion of the southern area of the Cherethites, in the territory which belongs to Judah, and of the southern area of Caleb; and we burned Ziklag with fire." 15 And David said to him, "Can you take me down to this troop?" So he said, "Swear to me by God that you will neither kill me nor deliver me into the hands of my master, and I will take you down to this troop." 16 And when he had brought him down, there they were, spread out over all the land, eating and drinking and dancing, because of all the great spoil which they had taken from the land of the Philistines and from the land of Judah. 17 Then David attacked them from twilight until the evening of the next day. Not a man of them escaped, except four hundred young men who rode on camels and fled. 18 So David recovered all that the Amalekites had carried away, and David rescued his two wives. 19 And nothing of theirs was lacking, either small or great, sons or daughters, spoil or anything which they had taken from them; David recovered all.

Joel 2: 18 - 27 (NKJV)

18 Then the Lord will be zealous for His land.

And pity His people.

19 The Lord will answer and say to His people,

"Behold, I will send you grain and new wine and oil,

And you will be satisfied by them;

I will no longer make you a reproach among the nations.

20 "But I will remove far from you the northern army,

And will drive him away into a barren and desolate land,

With his face toward the eastern sea

And his back toward the western sea;

His stench will come up, And his foul odor will rise,

Because he has done [a]monstrous things."

21 Fear not, O land; Be glad and rejoice,

For the Lord has done [b]marvelous things!

22 Do not be afraid, you beasts of the field;

For the open pastures are springing up,

And the tree bears its fruit; The fig tree and the vine yield their strength.

23 Be glad then, you children of Zion,

And rejoice in the Lord your God;

For He has given you the [c]former rain faithfully,

And He will cause the rain to come down for you—

The former rain, And the latter rain in the first month.

24 The threshing floors shall be full of wheat,

And the vats shall overflow with new wine and oil.

25 "So I will restore to you the years that the swarming [d]locust has eaten,

The crawling locust,

The consuming locust,

And the chewing locust,

My great army which I sent among you.

26 You shall eat in plenty and be satisfied,

And praise the name of the Lord your God,

Who has dealt wondrously with you;

And My people shall never be put to shame.

27 Then you shall know that I am in the midst of Israel:

I am the Lord your God

And there is no other.

My people shall never be put to shame.

RESILIENCE

By Reverend Rowland Henshaw

1 Samuel 30:1-9

30 David and his men reached Ziklag on the third day. Now the Amalekites had raided the Negev and Ziklag. They had attacked Ziklag and burned it, 2 and had taken captive the women and everyone else in it, both young and old. They killed none of them but carried them off as they went on their way.

3 When David and his men reached Ziklag, they found it destroyed by fire and their wives and sons and daughters taken captive. 4 So David and his men wept aloud until they had no strength left to weep. 5 David's two wives had been captured—Ahinoam of Jezreel and Abigail, the widow of Nabal of Carmel. 6 David was



greatly distressed because the men were talking of stoning him; each one was bitter in spirit because of his sons and daughters. But David found strength in the Lord his God.

7 Then David said to Abiathar the priest, the son of Ahimelek, "Bring me the ephod." Abiathar brought it to him, 8 and David inquired of the Lord, "Shall I pursue this raiding party? Will I overtake them?"

"Pursue them," he answered. "You will certainly overtake them and succeed in the rescue."

9 David and the six hundred men with him came to the Besor Valley, where some stayed behind. 10 Two hundred of them were too exhausted to cross the valley, but David and the other four hundred continued the pursuit.

Have you ever felt beaten up? Betrayed? Used? Abused? Deflated? Lost? Nothing seem to be making sense.

You are in a seemingly hopeless situation, YOU ARE DROWNING.

Every fibre in you is saying it is over, give up.

Everyone who looks at your situation is wondering if you will ever make it.

All you want to do is throw in the towel.

You look at your marriage. You look at your health. You look at your finances.

You look at your job. You have had so many miscarriages,

So many disappointments, Your business has not worked out the way you will want it to.

And you are about to give up.

You look at your children.

You feel lost and boxed in

You seem to be helmed in on every side and there is no way of escape.

.... EXHORTATION CNTD

Psalm 30:4-5

4 Sing praises to the Lord, O you his saints, and give thanks to his holy name.

5 For his anger is but for a moment, and his favor is for a lifetime. Weeping may tarry for the night, but joy comes with the morning.

Don't give up.

Stop and listen to what Paul says!

2 Corinthians 4:7-9

7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us.

8 We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair.

9 Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed.

2 Corinthians 7:4-6

4 Great is my boldness of speech toward you, great is my glorying of you: I am filled with comfort, I am exceeding joyful in all our tribulation.
5 For, when we were come into Macedonia, our flesh had no rest, but we were troubled on every side; without were fightings, within were fears.
6 Nevertheless God, that comforted those that are cast down, comforted us by the coming of Titus.

Are you cast down or feel defeated, deflated, demoralised etc?

God wants you to know today, that you have a treasure in this earthen vessel.

God has placed in you the capacity to be a victor.

God has placed in you the capacity to fight.

- You may be troubled on all sides.
- You may feel lost for words and wondering what God is doing.
- Why am I going through all of these, you may ask yourself.

I want to assure you today, that you are stronger than you think.

You are stronger than you are made to believe.

The word of God teaches us to be resilient, relentless, it teaches us not to give up.

What is resilience?

It is the capacity to recover quickly from difficulties, toughness:

"to rebound, recoil." As a character trait, it is the ability to recover quickly from misfortune, illness, or depression.

The ability to spring back into shape, just like an elastic.

There are many Christians who have thrown in the towel.

..... EXHORTATION CNTD

They have given up on God.

Yet the word of God tells from the pen of Paul the Apostle.

2 Corinthians 4:16-18

16 For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perishes, yet the inward man is renewed day by day.

Yet the inward man is renewed day by day.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE INWARD MAN AND THE OUT-WARD MAN.

The outward man is the physical body and its five senses of sight, hearing, smell, touch, and taste. These senses are man's medium for relating to his environment.

The human body can only receive information from this world through its five senses.

The inward man, however, is the human spirit and his soul; the seat of his mind, will, and emotions.

The inward man is the seat of the Holy Spirit, as you stay in tune with the Holy Spirit, you are being strengthened on the inside.

THE TREASURE IN AN EARTHEN VESSEL

Paul calls it the treasure in an earthen vessel. **But we have this treasure in earthen vessels.**

The outward man looks at its environs. Sees what is going on tells us, there is scarcity, there is sickness, the energy bills are going up.

Things are getting tough, it looks at the newspapers, it tells you that your mortgage will increase by so and so.

But the inner man relies and depends on the treasure on the inside.

Leans on the Holy Spirit for direction.

For wisdom

For help

The minute you allow your emotions or your sentiments to tell you that you are defeated you will be defeated.

2 Corinthians 4:17-18

17 For our light and momentary affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory that is far beyond comparison.

.... EXHORTATION CNTD ...

Producing or working what we go through produces glory, when compared to the eternal glory, what go through right now is light in comparison to the eternal glory.

18 So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen. For what is seen is temporary, but what is unseen is eternal.

That is why when Paul prayed for the Ephesians Church He said

Ephesians 3:14-16

14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,

15 Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, 16 That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man.

If you are not strengthened in your inner man, you will not see your situation as a light affliction.

You will not realise that it is momentarily.

You will have to go into 2023 resilient.

THINGS YOU CAN DO IN 2023

When you don't know what to do rather than complain or get angry with people and God.

- Pray
- Inquire from God
- Obey Him
- Wrestle before God and not with God
- Remind yourself of God's goodness don't just sing bring out your book of records!
- Wrestle before God in scriptures
- Wrestle before God in worship
- Wrestle before in praise
- Wrestle before God in intercession
- · Wrestle before God in thanksgiving

EXHORTATION CNTD

FINISHING IS BETTER THAN BEGINNING

Matthew 24:13

..... GOD LOVES YOU

God Loves YOU and wants you to have a relationship with Him through His son Jesus.

The Bible says that God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, Jesus, so that whoever believes in him shall not die, but have eternal life (John 3: 16).

The first step to know more of God is to obey His Word and receive Jesus as your Lord and Saviour, by simply repenting of your sins and believing that Jesus has died on the cross and paid the price for you to be reconciled to God for ever. GOD LOVES YOU!!!

GOD's Purpose: Peace and life God loves you and wants you to experience peace and life: abundant and eternal.

"we have peace with GOD through our Lord JESUS CHRIST." (Romans 5:1)

"I have come that they may have life in abundance." (John 10:10)



"for GOD so loved the world that he gave his only begotten SON, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

Why don't most people have this peace and abundant life that God planned for us to have?

The Problem: Our Separation God created us in his own image to have an abundant life. He did not make us as robots to automatically love and obey him. God gave us a will and a freedom of choice. We chose to disobey God and go our own wilful way. We still make this choice today. This results in separation from God.

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of GOD." (Romans 3:23) "for the wages of sin is death, but the gift of GOD is eternal life in CHRIST JESUS, our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

Our attempts to reach GOD People have tried many ways to bridge this gap between themselves and God....

"there is a way that seems right to man, but in the end it leads to death." (Proverbs 14:12) "but your iniquities have separated you from your GOD; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear." (Isaiah 59:2)

No bridge reaches GOD... except one...

GOD's Bridge: The Cross Jesus died on the cross and rose from the grave. He paid the penalty for our sin and bridged the gap between God and people.

for Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring GOD and men, that man you to GOD." (1 Peter 3:18)

"for there is one GOD and one mediator between JESUS CHRIST." (1 Timothy 2:5)

"but GOD demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, CHRIST died (Romans 5:8)
