

The Benefits of Living in His Presence

In the book of Genesis 3:23 therefore the Lord God sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.

We are told that Adam Eve was driven out of the Garden of Eden from the presence of the Lord. They lost all the benefit of chatting with God in the cool of the night. In **Genesis 3:8** we are told, **8** And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the



day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.

What is it that will make God's own creation hide from His presence? What is it that will make you and I hide from God's presence?

Think about it for a minute. Wow! What a privilege? Adam and Eve lost it because of their self-fish desires. Today, many of us like Adam and Eve are missing out on living in His presence, for many reasons, such as busyness, distractions, sins, lack of trust, or that His presence is of lesser importance to us.

I can only imagine what it would have been like to live in the presence of God, in the garden of Eden, listening to God, having a conversation with God in the cool of the night.

Absence from His presence brings toil and pain.

When David messed up, he realised that his absence from the presence of God has deprived him of His God's joy, so he cried unto God.

Psalm 51:11-12

11 Do not cast me away from Your presence, And do not take Your Holy Spirit from me. 12 Restore to me the joy of Your salvation And

uphold me by Your generous Spirit.

God wants us to live in His presence, He wants us to come into His presence with boldness and enjoy His goodness.

Psalm 16:11 You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

We find the path of life by living in His presence, there is a path of life that many long to walk in but miss it because God is not the centre of their life. Joy eludes many because they do not realise that the pathway to joy is found in living the presence of God, many long for pleasure in the wrong things and places when it can only be found dwelling in His presence.

Moses realised the benefits of living in God's presence and so refused to move or do anything without God's presence.

Exodus 33:15 Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here. 16 For how then will it be known that Your people and I have found grace in Your sight, except You go with us? So, we shall be separate, Your people and I, from all the people who are upon the face of the earth."

The presence of God in any situation of our lives is the evidence of God's grace, in Exodus 33: 13 Now therefore, I pray, if I have found grace in Your sight, show me now Your way, that I may know You and that I may find grace in Your sight. And consider that this nation is Your people."

God's presence is what makes a difference in the lives of every believer, His presence fills you with confidence, His presence brings direction, living in His presence is the sign of deep intimacy.

What does it mean to live in His presence? To live in His presence is to be where He is, it is to make His presence your dwelling place, to make His presence your abode.

First Word

In Psalm 91:1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 2 I will say of the Lord, "He is my refuge and my fortress. My God, in Him I will trust."

Psalm 91:1 tells us that it is the person who trusts in God that will dwell in God's presence, he/she lives close to God, because they know that to live in His presence is to be secure.

Verse 9 -10 say, **9 Because you have made the Lord, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place, 10 No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling.**

God's presence is a strong tower for the righteous to run to and be saved.

Exodus 33:16 How will anyone know that you are pleased with me and with your people unless you go with us? What else will distinguish me and your people from all the other people on the face of the earth"?

To live in His presence distinguishes you from other people, and this is evidence in your lifestyle, your choices, your speech, and attitude. Those who live in His presence, live a life of the supernatural, a life of favour, a victorious life.

Living in His presence does not exclude us from dangers and challenges, but His presence fills us with a supernatural confidence that cannot be explained. In the book of Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were accused of not bowing down to the golden image set up by King Nebuchadnezzar. On been threatened on what would happen to them, they gave one of the most powerful testimonies of their confidence in God.

Daniel 3:16-18

16 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego answered and said to the king, "O Nebuchadnezzar, we have no need to answer you in this matter. 17 If that is the case, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and He will deliver us from your hand, O king. 18 But if not, let it be known to you, O king, that we



do not serve your gods, nor will we worship the gold image which you have set up."

This confidence can only come from those who have and continued to live in the presence of the living God.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO LIVE IN HIS PRESENCE?

To live means to make a place a home, a dwelling place, an abode, a place of residence, a place of rest, to sit down, to stay, a place of settlement, a place where you remain with someone of importance, someone you value and love to be with.

Therefore, in our Christian walk, living in His Presence is sitting with God in communal fellowship, a treasure that nothing on this earth can purchase. Finding time on a daily basis to commune with Him in the secret place. Creating a place and time of solitude in Praise, adoration, worship, reading of the word, inquiring, loving Him, prayer and fasting.

Elijah was able to declare to Ahab with confidence, that his word there would be no rain for three and the half years and there was no rain.

Where did this man find such boldness. He tells us himself in 1 Kings 17:1

And Elijah the Tishbite, of the inhabitants of Gilead, said to Ahab, "As the Lord God of Israel lives, <u>before whom I stand</u>, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, except at my word."

Elijah made it clear to Ahab that he was a man who lived in the presence of the almighty God.

I pray that God will give us all the resilience, the patience, the hunger, the joy and desire to live in His presence in 2024.

Living in His presence is loaded with numerous benefits. May we all be partakers of the heavenly benefits in Jesus' name.

Are You Thirsty?

John 7:37-39

Fasting is an important aspect of building our faith and drawing closer to God for Christians. Fasting enables us to crucify the flesh and allow our spirit man the sensitivity to the Holy Spirit.

I have over the years heard of several types of fast - the dry, partial, liquid, Daniel and mixed fast. I believe that the Bible actually talks about fasting as abstinence from food and liquid. However, over the years we have added our own dimensions to fasting. Such as the Daniel fast, the partial fast, fasting from social media, etc. I am not saying that there is anything wrong with these styles of fasts. If that is what you feel led to do, in your personal time with God then do it. I know how beneficial it has been for some people.

We must however take our cue from scripture. How did Jesus fast? *Matthew 4:2 - And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry. *

Jesus' fast was without food or water. He was in the desert 40 days and forty nights, and this was not in UAE desert. This was no Emirate or Quatar airways to bring Him food or water in the desert.

Exodus 24:18 18 - So Moses went into the midst of the cloud and went up into the mountain. And Moses was on the mountain forty days and forty nights.

So, Moses was on the mountain 40 days and 40 nights without food or water.

In the book of Jonah, we are told that the king of Nineveh called a fast in *Jonah 3:5-7*

*5 So the people of Nineveh believed God, proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest to the least of them. 6 Then word came to the king of Nineveh; and he arose from his throne and laid aside his robe, covered himself with sackcloth and sat in

ashes. 7 And he caused it to be proclaimed and published throughout Nineveh by the decree of the king and his nobles, saying, Let neither man nor beast, herd nor flock, taste anything; do not let them eat, or drink water.*

In Word of Life, we practice the dry fast, from 6:00AM to 6:00PM, abstaining from food and drink. We are also very cognisant of the elderly and those with medical conditions, hence the partial fast. There are some who are on medication and will need to take a meal before taking their medication, this is very much allowed.

However, the effectiveness of our fasting is based on two things, praying, and reading the word whilst you fast. We do not abstain from prayer and the Word during our fasting.

From the 2nd of January 2024, we embarked on a 7day fast as we sought God afresh. Please be part of this continuous journey of fasting in 2024, for a fresh and continuous outpouring of God.

John 7:37 On the last and greatest day of the festival, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink.

He is calling those who are thirsty to come. Let us keep coming to Him corporately and tell Him how thirsty we are. God bless you.



Genesis 3 v 8




Bible Book of the Month

THE BOOK OF LAMENTATIONS

This month, let's join to read, meditate, study, and explore the book of LAMENTATIONS.

The book of Lamentations is a book of sorrowful songs or poems. The name implies that the topic is expressing grief over something (to lament). Jeremiah, also known as the "weeping prophet" writes this after the destruction of Jerusalem by the Babylonians. It was written soon after the fall of Jerusalem in 586 B.C.; he was an eyewitness. He predicted this destruction (as did others), watched it take place, and now in this book he is sadly reflecting on it. Key personalities are the prophet Jeremiah and the people of Jerusalem. Its purpose was to express despair and teach God's people that disobedience to the Lord results in immense suffering and distress. Jeremiah pours out his emotions in compassion, and empathy for God's nation, as he watches them inhabit a foreign land.
