





EXHORTATION

FINDING FAVOUR WITH GOD AND MEN

By Reverend Rowland Henshaw

1 Samuel 2:26

26 And the child Samuel grew in stature, and in favor both with the Lord and men.

Luke 2:52

52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

Our theme for the month of July is, "God's Favour". Every one of us do need favour at one time or the other. I have however found out that, all we need is God's favour. God's favour, simply put is God stepping into our situation to make a difference. I am not talking about the unmerited favour of God —



Grace. I am talking about connecting with God's goodness, mercy and grace. When it looks as though everyone else is struggling, fighting and pulling their hair out to find favour from men, because you are connected to His goodness, mercy and grace. His favour opens door to you. The above scriptures clearly indicates that Samuel and Jesus increased in favour with God and so found favour with men.

People came to Jesus from all over to listen to Him, miracles, signs and wonders followed His ministry, people gave to His ministry, People helped Him even at His death and burial. His cross was carried by Simon of Cyrene (Matthew 27:32), His tomb was a gift from Joseph of Arimathea a rich man (Isaiah 53:4 - 6, 10 - 11, Matthew 27:57 - 60, Luke 23:50 - 53)

Samuel also grew in favour with God and with man, God did not allow any of his word to fall to the ground (1 Samuel 3:19). He was highly revered by all; God gave Him honour. When we find favour with God; we are bound to find favour with men.

When a man has God's favour upon his life, he/she will be connected to everything good that is from God. When God's hand is upon your life, His goodness will follow you in time of adversity. Joseph was a slave in Egypt, yet he found favour with Potiphar in a foreign land, because hand was upon his life.

Genesis 39:1-4

Now Joseph had been taken (A)down to Egypt. And (B)Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh, captain of the guard, an Egyptian, bought him from the Ishmaelites who had taken him down there. 2 The Lord was with Joseph, and he was a successful man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian. 3 And his master saw that the Lord was with him and that the Lord made all he did to prosper in his hand. 4 So Joseph found favor in his sight, and served him. Then he made him overseer of his house, and all that he had he put under his authority.

. EXHORTATION CNTD .

Because God's favour was with Joseph, everything Joseph did prospered, Joseph was successful, he found promotion in the most unlikely places, even in prison.

Genesis 39:21-23

21 But the Lord was with Joseph and showed him mercy, and He gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison. 22 And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners who were in the prison; whatever they did there, it was his doing. 23 The keeper of the prison did not look into anything that was under Joseph's authority, because the Lord was with him; and whatever he did, the Lord made it prosper.

God gave Joseph favour because Joseph had found favour with God.

Many times, we try very hard, looking for favour with our employers, with friends, with people in general. It eludes us, we become frustrated, we become upset and sometimes dejected and depressed. I want to submit to you today that it is more difficult to find favour with man if you have not obtained favour from God.

Proverbs 12: 2 says A good man obtains favor from the Lord, But a man of wicked intentions He will condemn.

A good man is not a perfect person, but has obtained God's grace, because he has made the Lord God his habitation. He has chosen God as his saviour. He has chosen to trust and believe God as his redeemer. A good man is that man who fears and honours the Lord. A good man obtains God's divine kindness and His act of true compassion.

The book of proverbs says – When a man's way pleases the Lord even the man's enemy is at peace with him. **Proverbs 16:7**

Today I want you to know child of God, that if God is for you, no one can be against you. (Romans 8:31)

QUESTION & ANSWER WITH MRS OLUREMI ADEJUMO

(FONDLY KNOWN AS M.A OR MRS A.)

1. Why did you become a youth leader?

I always followed my parents to church, we didn't really have a choice, although I enjoyed it, I did not really understand the purpose but I really didn't mind because I got to go to the sweet shop and have Chinese rice after service as my parent's were active in the church which meant we were usually the last to leave church. However, this turned around when I accepted Jesus Christ as my personal Lord and Saviour at 14 years old (some 35+ years ago).



Life changed dramatically and I journeyed through life knowing that I was unique, worthy of God's love, could do or be anything, had a definite destiny and most of all created in the image and likeness of God. I felt like superman (LOL). I believe that knowing God young really shaped the trajectory of my life and having a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and coming to know the Holy Spirit, <u>literally</u> gave me super (natural) powers for free!! I figured that it would be an honour to support young people in finding their place in the world through knowing Christ (the living Word), the love of God, the power of the Holy Spirit and understanding their purpose in line with 1 Peter 2vs 9 – but you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may delay

2. What is the vision of the Youth Connect?

Our youth ministry mainly consists of the:

- a. Youth Connect/cell group -which is a cell group of young believers in our church. The goal is to 'make, mature and mobilise disciples'.
- b. Youth Hub is a community connect initiative for youth/young people aged 11 21 that reside within Grove Park and the wider Lewisham Borough.

For each young person to come into a personal walk with God through a personal, active and vibrant relationship with Jesus Christ. Through this support them in finding their identity in Christ, seeing and fulfilling their potential; recognising their gifting(s); and encouraging then to use these to be a blessing to their family and others. Our ultimate desire is that they are clear about "who and whose they are" and make a positive difference in their generations.

3. What are your goals for 2022?

We have a number of goals but will focus on

Fellowship, Growth/Leadership, Friendship and Service

Fellowship – transformative fellowship with the Lord Jesus and within the church setting corporate fellowship with others of similar ages. This is encouraged through the knowledge, the study of the Holy Scriptures in the Bible and its practical application to

daily living; and connecting with others through the Youth Ministry.

Growth/Leadership—taking on new challenges in church and society; stepping outside of their comfort zone; taking responsibility and being accountable

Friendship - As they build relationships they grow into friendships where they support each other, pray and build memories together.

Service – Jesus Christ's life was one of service, as He is our main role model, we would serve in the church setting, in the community and wider society.

4. What are the barriers, if any, to a lack of engagement or attendance?

In regards to the cell meetings, limited time to hang out; however, when exam season comes around one may not necessarily attend church as much or if their parents can't attend they tend not to come but we have some who make their own way which is a great boost.

During the winter months when it gets dark quickly some may not be keen to attend the Youth Hub which is in the evening but we ensure that we arrange for them to get home so this does not hinder their attendance.

5. How can parents help their children to grow spiritually?

Family Time: Set a regular family time to share, discuss the bible and pray together;

Model acceptable behaviour: Be a great role model, youth tend to imitate what they see. If you don't study your bible, work hard, keep to time, pray or serve others, it will be challenging to expect your youth to do so

Listen and Learn:- Be open to questions, don't shy away from challenging questions, if you don't know the answer say so and find someone that can help

Connectivity & Relationship building: Stay connected with your children. Spend time with them. Build relationships with them, have fun together, spend time together. Always remember you were a child once so don't be judgemental in your responses. Consider how Jesus related to the little ones and how He built relationships with His disciples

Serving in the church – encourage them to be actively involved in church. This encourages, responsibility, accountability and developments a host of skills and capabilities at a young age.

6. What has been the highlight this year?

Although we have focused on building relationships and encouraging the youth to be consistent in their cell meetings and the youth hub, the highlights that come to mind, firstly was their performance on Father's day event. They ministered their poem with boldness, great stage presence, and were comfortable with the congregation.

.. YOUTH MINISTRY Q & A CNTD .

Afterwards they waited on the men, serving them food, arranging take away packs, the cutting of the cake and staying afterwards to tidy up. Secondly, the Big Lunch where they arranged and coordinated the Jubilee Quiz, shared their experience of the Youth Hub and Cell groups and interacted with the community. Seeing their growth in their interaction and expression was a true joy and a glimpse of what was to come.

7. What is your biggest joy in this ministry?

There are many, but the one that comes to mind, is seeing them grow in confidence and relationships blossoming. I love their lively and spirited personalities regardless of temperament it is just what being young is about. They are more comfortable in

church, they participate in activities and events, they support each other and interact with other young people in community events.

8. What strategy do you employ for youths to engage in constant bible reading and praying; including activities that help them grow in their faith?

Now this is a tricky one as it is only the Lord that truly knows how engaged we all are:

That said we do employ various techniques by showing them how to study by explaining how to use a study bible, employing the S.O.A.P method (see attached picture) when meditating on scripture, learning godly songs with wholesome lyrics.

Practically, we require all youth to bring their bible to church and take notes;

We also aim is for a different person to summarise the Sunday sermon each week, this encourages study and also provides a snapshot for the youth to read.

Using the whiteboard during the cell meetings one of the youth writes down what stood out for each person in the sermon and we creatively use different scenarios to break it down in such a way that makes it easier to understand. We aim to make it as interactive as possible. We also pray for each other during these sessions.

Youth post prayer requests are through our WhatsApp group

Encourage them to always find a scripture that relates to a challenge or an issue that occurs in their personal life so they can anchor their hope on the living Word, Jesus. For example, recently we learnt that society rated 6 key items as being the most important things to them. The Youth were tasked to find scriptures that addressed those items and further

Although the list is endless, some of the key activities that encourage them to grow in their faith include:

1)The youth being responsible for organising a Youth Service, this is where the youth are responsible for the service from end to end. Praise and Worship, Offering, the Announcements. This is a practical way for them to witness to others the inherent gifts and talents they have been blessed with and it enables them to grow in boldness and being a witness.

.. YOUTH MINISTRY Q & A CNTD

- 2)The youth cell participates in the SoS evangelism which encourages us to witness to our neighbours and is a great way to work with others to reach out with the Good News;
- 3)Encouraging them to lead a prayer point at our gatherings. Here they articulate their prayers and learn how to confidently pray. We are also in the process of setting up a prayer buddying scheme to create regular prayer connections; mentoring scheme and there are other activities in the pipeline;
- 4)We encourage them to participate in church activities and join departments. Currently we have a number of youth in the technical department where they learn responsibility, accountability and most of all service;
- 5)We run a body and soul fitness event every Tuesday for boys and men of all ages which includes a discussion group as well;
- 6)A number of youth are currently learning the drums and this also has a discussion group;
- 7)We also discuss how to live out their believes at home, school, and the community. We also encourage them to seek peace at home (fight sibling rivalry with love and be willing to be the first to seek peace), inviting friends to church or reach out to their friends about God and to be an example at school by taking on challenges knowing that they are called to be leaders;
- 8)Participate in youth encounter activities;
- 9)Encouraging them to put what they have learnt into action is key to growth. For example, if the sermon was on loving your neighbour, applying that to helping someone out at school or even seeking peace with a sibling;

9. How do you encourage the young people to attend the youth cell and youth hub?

Make it resourceful, interesting and if possible fun, something that they want to come too. As they build relationships they want to continue to interact with others. Also it doesn't hurt to have refreshments at these events, so this is something we always have available. Ensure that social activities are also a key feature of the ministry – In January for example we watched Prince of Egypt in the theatre

10. How do you handle difficult questions from the youths?

As Youth workers, our job is to be there to support them. Key is to listen respectfully without judging and take it from there. A young person needs to trust you so listen. Always remember what it was like to be young and how you wanted to be heard. So, listening is the first and most important step and then seeking to understand before addressing the question and be truthful if you are not sure and seek out the answer from others who may have more experience.

Why don't most people have this peace and abundant life that God planned for us to have?
