... FIRST WORD. CREATED FOR PURPOSE

Every one of us have been created by God for a purpose. You might not know or have discovered what that purpose is but you were not created just to occupy space.

Our lives sometimes are filled with numerous activities that we become completely oblivious of what our real purpose is on this earth. We are sometimes driven by the demands of life and lose sight of God's greater purpose for our lives.

We must stop and evaluate our daily routine to realise that God's purpose for our lives are not just about us, but it also encompasses the lives of others around us and beyond - at home, school, work, in our businesses community, city, nation and even beyond our nation(s).

The Bible says in the book of Jeremiah 29:11 11 For I know the plans I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

God says He knows the plans He has for you. That means you were not just created to have a home, education, have children etc. God's plan for your life is a lot more than these things. The truth is that God has a purpose for everyone.

He said to Jeremiah in Jeremiah 1:4-5

4 The word of the Lord came to me, saying, 5 'Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you, before you were born, I set you apart; I appointed you as a prophet to the nations.'

God had a plan and a purpose for Jeremiah even before Jeremiah was even formed in his mother's womb. God chose him to be His voice to nations.

You also were born for a purpose. Everyone of God's creation has a purpose determined by God. More so His children who are believers in Christ. You might not know it now, but God will make it clear if you seek Him.

Proverbs 20:5 "The purposes of a person's heart are deep waters, but one who has insight draws them out".

Many people lack peace, joy, direction and fulfilment because they are yet to discover what their purpose is, talk less of live it out

We are God's workmanship, crafted by God for His purpose, for good works. God has good works for you and I to discover, embrace and fulfil.

Ephesians 2:10

10 For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

When I read about the life of Joseph, I see a young man who God had a great purpose and destiny for. Even though God showed Joseph dreams of greatness, Joseph's father and siblings had no clue of how these dreams were going to materialise. Joseph too did not have a clue of how and where.

You might know what God has called you to, your purpose. However, it might be that at this moment everything seems so far from what you believe God has said to you. Do not fret or be afraid, nor give up. Joseph did not realise what God was doing with him, when his dreams seemed so far away from fulfilment. It took several God ordained situations and circumstances before Joseph finally saw the bigger picture of God's purpose for His life being fulfilled. When it got to that stage, He said this to his siblings in Genesis 50:20:

20 You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives.






.....GOD LOVES YOU

God Loves YOU and wants you to have a relationship with Him through His son Jesus.


The Bible says that God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, Jesus, so that whoever believes in him shall not die, but have eternal life (John 3: 16).

1st to 14th June 2019 THEME: PRAYING IN THE FIRE OF REVIVAL

Saturday 1st June 2019

Leviticus 6:12-13, Malachi 3:1-4

Fire represents God's cleansing, sanctification and purification. Today let us pray that as a church and as individuals we will always remain in that place of sanctification and that God's fire will cleanse and purify. Pray that God's fire will never be put out from the altar of our heart. Let us pray that God will purify us and prepare us for the revival that is on its way. Let us pray that God's fire will refine us, refine Grove Park and usher in the awaited revival.

Sunday 2nd June 2019

Mathew 3:11, Acts 1:4, Acts 2:17-19

John the Baptist said that Jesus will baptise us with The Holy Spirit and Fire. Let us cry out to God for a manifestation of that baptism today. Let us cry out to God for an outpouring of His Fire to usher in the revival. Based on Acts 1:4, let us tarry in His presence today and remind the Lord of the promise to baptise us with fire. Let us pray for a tangible outpouring of God's Spirit upon Mayeswood Road, Grove Park and as we hold the big lunch. We want to see God touch every one from the community that is celebrating the big lunch with us today. Monday 3rd June 2019

Tuesday 4th June 2019

Luke 24:32, Psalm 119:25

Today Let us pray that God's Word will burn like fire in the hearts of every hearer. Let us pray that we will be revived according to God's word. That lives will be changed and transformed.

Wednesday 5th June 2019 Habakkuk 3:2 and Acts 1:8

"O LORD, I have heard the report of You; I stand in awe, O LORD, of Your deeds. Revive them in these years; make them known in these years. In Your wrath, remember mercy!

Today let us pray that revival will start with us. Make this a personal prayer.

O Lord let revival begin with me here now! Revive me o Lord, revive my household. Create an undying passion in me for You. Pray for a passion for God and His kingdom today and always.

Thursday 6th June 2019

Acts 2: 1 – 14.

Let's pray for another Pentecost that will be experienced by all. The early Church was relevant to their community. Let us pray that as a Church we will be relevant in this community where God has planted us as we experience another Pentecost.

Friday 7th June 2019

Zechariah 13:9

Let's pray fervently for our children and our youth. That they will encounter God's fire and that their lives will bring God glory. Pray that they will be filled with faith and boldness to declare God's word. Pray that God will refine them as gold and silver.

Pray that our children will call on God and trust God with all their heart.

Saturday 8th of June 2019

1 Thessalonians 1:4-5

Let us pray today for our young ones that they will declare God's Word with power and authority. Pray that signs and wonders will follow them where ever they go.

Sunday 9th of June 2019

Hosea 6:2, Isaiah 64:1 -3, John 4:24

Let us pray that God will rend the heavens and come down and make His name known in our community and city. Let us pray that every mountain that is an obstacle to revival in our community and city will be made plain at the presence of our God. Let us pray that God will make His name known to the people of Grove Park. Let us pray that the fire of God will consume every anti-Christ spirit in our community and city. Let us pray for deliverance from every bondage in the name of Jesus. Let us pray that everyone that is held in bondage in our midst and in our community will experience deliverance in the name of Jesus. Pray for God's move in Grove Park, Lewisham and London. Monday 10th of June 2019 Acts 2:1-4

Let us pray that every believer in the church will receive the Baptism of the Holy Spirit. Let us pray that there will be a strong boldness to witness and preach the gospel. Judges 6:28-40

"When the men of the town rose early in the morning, behold, the altar of Baal was broken down, and the Asherah beside it was cut down.,"

Let us pray and declare that the consuming fire of God will burn up every altar and high place of idolatry in Grove Park. Let us pray that the fire of God will consume altars of sexual immorality, sexual perversion and every ordinance and ideology set up against the knowledge of God and propagation of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Wednesday 12th of June 2019

Nehemiah 1:9

"but if you return to me and keep my commandments and do them, though your outcasts are in the uttermost parts of heaven, from there I will gather them and bring them to the place that I have chosen, to make my name dwell there.""

Let us pray WOL will continue to be a Lighthouse in the community. Let us pray that the light and fire of God in WOL will shine so bright that men everywhere will see it.
