♦ INTRODUCING MISSIONARY JESUS EVENINGS


The whole Church is invited to join the Missionary Jesus Evenings starting Friday 4th June at Rehoboth building.

The Chosen Generation Youth Hub is a Youth Ministry / Chosen Generation Community Connect initiative for youth/young people aged 11–21, that reside within the Mottingham / Grove Park, and the wider Lewisham Borough area. The need for this project arose following a survey carried out with a cross section of residents living in the Grove Park area, where one of the key and repeated needs highlighted was for a place for the youth.

Aim and Vision:

The aim and vision is to provide a safe environment for young people to enjoy spending time together socially with others, providing games, a Chill & Chat space, food, music, quiz nights, movie nights, creative art opportunities and much more. There will also be outdoor activities and events organised from time to time.

Through the hub, we aim to reach young people in the area, introducing Jesus to them. In addition to empower, engage, encourage and inspire the young people, not only by providing space and resources, but through resourcing them with necessary

life skills and challenging them to be the best they can be, through various workshops and mentoring sessions. ♦ CONSOLIDATION (FOLLOW UP) MINISTRY

The Consolidation Ministry is a vital ministry in the Church (Galatians 4:19). Consolidation can be defined as "the care and attention we should give to the new believer in order to reproduce Christ's character in him or her". Consolidation is the process by which we establish new believers



in the faith, so that they move forward on to maturity and do not slip back into their old ways. Consolidation for a believer should be a lifestyle as well as a team process. Here at WOL we have a consolidation team and that team consists of those we call CONSOLIDATORS.

The ministry they carry out is wide and varied. It includes taking new believers through the process of explaining the decision they have made for Christ and verifying that decision, praying with them and for their needs, taking personal and contact details by completing a verification form, answering their questions, making a phone call within 48 hours, visiting them within a week, referring them to a cell group and encouraging them to join the cell group, being an available friend to them etc.

♦ WORSHIP AT WORD OF LIFE CHURCH, REHOBOTH BUILDING WITH CONFIDENCE

Rehoboth Building is OPEN for our regular Sunday and Wednesday services.

We continue to follow the government and Elim's guidelines with the aim of keeping you safe while Rehoboth Building is open. We encourage you to continue to embrace these and work with us as we continue to fellowship and worship the Lord in person. Rehoboth Building is open to the whole WOL family, the community and the general public for services.

Below are:

- (1) Actions the CHURCH is taking to ensure your safety.
- (2) Actions required of YOU to ensure our collective safety.

What We Are Doing

- (1) Enforcing the requirement of registration to attend church services.
- (2) Check-in upon arrival, to aid contact tracing
- (3) Cleaning of shared areas and surfaces
- (4) Significantly Adjusted Seating to promote Physical distancing.
- (5) Physical Distancing and other Signs and Stickers posted in and out of the building for your attention.
- (6) Slightly reduced length of singing time with a maximum of 2 singers and and1 instrumentalist at each service. Separate designated microphones are provided per each user (Singers and Speakers during each service)
- (7) Provision of individual packaged communion emblems for all
- (8) Personal Protective Equipment (disposable masks and gloves) provided for stewards
- (9) Hand Sanitiser stations placed at the Entry Point and Exit points. Hand sanitising is required for all upon entry and exit.
- (10) Still not able to join us in person due to having to self-isolate, sickness, old age or other reasons? Online services continue to hold.

What We Need from You

- (1) Please register all members in your family before attending in-person services and check-in at the check in point upon arrival. You will need to register via the church website at www.wordoflife-lcc.org for each service you wish to attend
- (2) Please use the hand sanitisers provided when entering the building and when exiting.

- (3) The stewards are there to help. Please strictly follow their instructions for your safety and the safety of others
- (4) Family members are required to please sit together. Parents, please plan to keep young children with you at all times (except during the time they go to the lower hall for the Children's church and youth cell)
- (5) Handshaking and hugging are strongly not allowed
- (6) Please use the main front doors for entry and for exit. The stewards will be on hand to help and guide you
- (7) Please come with, and wear a mask during your time in Rehoboth Building. Children under 11 do not have to have face masks on.
- (8) Refreshments (food and drink) will not be distributed at this time
- (9) If you need a drink during the service, please kindly come in with a bottle of water. This is not to be shared with others.
- (10) Please choose ONLINE giving and other non-cash methods where possible. If unable to do this, you can still give cash in during the in-person services at Rehoboth Building
- (11) We appreciate your patience and co-operation.

In this season, we encourage you to continue to prioritise safety, and to choose faith over fear. It is been an unprecedented time in history, so if you are feeling mentally drained, you are not alone. God is with you and will never leave you nor forsake you. We also encourage you to speak to someone about how you are feeling. Speak to your cell leader, or deputy cell leader, or one of the other Word of Life leaders.

We love you and look forward to seeing you back in Word of Life Church Rehoboth Building in-person, if you haven't returned already!

JONAH & THE BOAT - ANOINTED AND IN THE WRONG PLACE!

There are many reasons why we face spiritual warfare. Jesus of course faced much of it, and indeed warned us in John 16v33 that we would have many troubles (but take heart because He has over-come the world). Some warfare however can be avoided....



Jonah was told clearly by the Lord to go to Nineveh to give them God's word, however he decided instead to get on a boat and head to Tarshish! This caused absolute havoc! He should not have been on the ship and now everyone onboard was suffering because of him. Have you ever considered that the turmoil in your life could be due to you or someone around you refusing to obey the call of God on your/their lives? The very environment around us reacts to the anointing upon us. To be anointed and called of God and stubborn and disobedient is not an issue that will sit quietly....

Jonah was anointed and commissioned by the Lord to go directly to a place of great influence, with a specific message that would result in the salvation and deliverance of the whole city. Because of Jonah, the Lord sent a storm upon the sea (Jonah 1v4) that was so fierce, the sailors lost all their cargo in an attempt to lighten their load..... scared for their very lives.

Where was Jonah during this commotion?Below deck, completely oblivious of the storm he had caused. Why was he in a deep sleep? Was he 'switching off' from the conviction he must have been feeling? How is it possible to be so disconnected from a life-threatening storm when everyone else is working like crazy to save their lives?

Without knowing the storm was Jonah's fault, the captain of the ship finds Jonah asleep during the storm and says to him in Jonah 1v6, "how can you sleep? Get up and call on your god! Maybe he will take notice of us so that we will not perish". The captain could not believe Jonah's lethargy in such a life-threatening situation and commands him to pray to his God.

The sailors realised somehow that something was wrong. This was no ordinary storm. Is your storm ordinary? Is there something in your life the Lord has told you to do repeatedly, that you have continually ignored? Are people suffering for your lack of obedience? Are prayers, as yet unanswered, due to your refusal to accept responsibility?

The Lord exposed Jonah by lot, and Verse 10 tells us that Jonah confesses all and told the sailors that he had fled from the presence of the Lord. They, not knowing the Lord, are shocked at his behaviour and exclaim, "Why have you done this?" they ask him what they should do to make the storm stop. The Lord had not relented the storm, and at this point it was continuing to grow worse, this shows us that the storm

may well have climaxed and taken the ship down had Jonah refused to confess or change his actions. Sometimes only quick obedience will suffice.

Jonah's area 'spewed him out'. His environment could not tolerate him. He did not belong there and it refused to keep still and quiet. Leviticus 18v28 is a verse that tells the Israelites that if they defiled the land, it would vomit them out as it vomited out the nations that were before them. In Genesis 12 v 14-20 Pharoah's house 'rocked' because of Abraham who had allowed his wife to be taken into Pharoah's house due to his lie that she was a single woman.

Jonah thankfully saw sense and repented, and the Lord sent a great deliverance for him. Let us respond to the great call of God and follow Him, it can be easier in the long run!

COULD YOU NOT WATCH WITH ME FOR ONE HOUR?



Matthew 26:40

Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, "What! Could you not watch with Me one hour?

We sometimes miss the importance of prayer because we do not understand it's importance.

Jesus said to His disciples could you not watch with me for just one hour.



Prayer keeps you away from falling.

Prayer strengthens your faith.

Prayer keeps you from losing faith.

Prayer energises you to keep going.

Jesus said in Luke 18:1

Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart,

However, the scripture that caught my attention is found in the book of Luke 21:34-36

³⁴ "But take heed to yourselves, lest your hearts be weighed down with carousing, drunkenness, and cares of this life, and that Day come on you unexpectedly. ³⁵ For it will come as a snare on all those who dwell on the face of the whole earth. ³⁶ Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man."

The key is in the statement watch therefore and pray always that you may be counted worthy.

To watch and pray is one of the most important aspects of our Christian walk.

Just to be a believer is not enough, we must be believers who watch and pray.

Jesus said to His disciples, to watch and pray, which was one of His last statements to His disciples before He was arrested in the garden of Gethsemane.

..... EXHORTATION Cntd......

Matthew 26:41

Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak."

Jesus understood the power of the flesh over the spirit – He understood that we will be tired, we will be weary, we may get frustrated and even become despondent. He knew our willingness to serve God will be put to the test. So, He counselled us to be alert, focus and always in prayer.

Peter counsels us also in the book of 1 Peter 4:7

But the end of all things is at hand; therefore, be serious and watchful in your prayers.

Yes, to watch and pray was Jesus' counsel of alertness, both in the spirit and in the physical.

The book of Nehemiah gives us a very good picture of what Jesus was saying when He said to us to watch and pray,

Nehemiah 4:9

Nevertheless we made our prayer to our God, and because of them we set a watch against them day and night.

Whilst they were praying to God, they kept watch because they did not want the enemies to creep up on them at night. They were alert.

For too long the Church had been asleep and the enemy crept in sowed all sort and we woke up to find our children, spouses, siblings struggling with one addiction or the other.

Nehemiah and his men did not just pray but they kept watch day and night.

As believers, we cannot ignore the time we are living in, just as the sons of Issachar, we must know the season we are in. Let us not be carried away by the entertainment, the cares of this world etc. The events of the end time may not be evident in the physical. We must not allow the day of the return of Jesus take us by surprise.

In Nehemiah 4:16-18

¹⁶ So it was, from that time on, that half of my servants worked at construction, while the other half held the spears, the shields, the bows, and wore armour; and the leaders were behind all the house of Judah. ¹⁷ Those who built on the wall, and those who carried burdens, loaded themselves so that with one hand they worked at construction, and with the other held a weapon. ¹⁸ Every one of the builders had his sword girded at his side as he built. And the one who sounded the trumpet was beside me.

Nehemiah's servants had those who carried the shovels and mortar, and had those who carried weapons and were on the lookout to warn the others of danger.

To watch is to be alert, to be focussed, discerning, observant, remain awake, exercise care, caution, or restraint.


The only way to remain alert is when we are connected to Heaven through prayers.

The ultimate goal of prayer is not deliverance, it is not healing, it is not to get the things we need from God. The ultimate goal of prayer is relationship. The ultimate goal of prayer is connection with God.

John 16:13

However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

As we watch we should be connected to heaven in relationship, be connected to Him.

GOD's Purpose: Peace and life God loves you and wants you to experience peace and life: abundant and eternal.

"we have peace with GOD through our Lord JESUS CHRIST." (Romans 5:1)

"I have come that they may have life in abundance." (John 10:10)



"for GOD so loved the world that he gave his only begotten SON, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

Why don't most people have this peace and abundant life that God planned for us to have?

The Problem: Our Separation God created us in his own image to have an abundant life. He did not make us as robots to automatically love and obey him. God gave us a will and a freedom of choice. We chose to disobey God and go our own wilful way. We still make this choice today. This results in separation from God.

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of GOD." (Romans 3:23) "for the wages of sin is death, but the gift of GOD is eternal life in CHRIST JESUS, our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

Our attempts to reach GOD People have tried many ways to bridge this gap between themselves and God....

"there is a way that seems right to man, but in the end it leads to death." (Proverbs 14:12) "but your iniquities have separated you from your GOD; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear." (Isaiah 59:2)

No bridge reaches GOD... except one...

GOD's Bridge: The Cross Jesus died on the cross and rose from the grave. He paid the penalty for our sin and bridged the gap between God and people.

for Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring GOD and men, that man you to GOD." (1 Peter 3:18)

"for there is one GOD and one mediator between JESUS CHRIST." (1 Timothy 2:5)

"but GOD demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, CHRIST died (Romans 5:8)

GOD has provided the only way. Each person must make a choice!



Our Response: Receive CHRIST We must trust Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour and receive him by personal invitation.
