Exhortation

THE RENEWED MIND

Romans 12:2 2Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will ishis good, pleasing and perfect will.

A person with a renewed mind has a choice as to what he/she wants to do or be in life.

Paul in this scripture calls believers to a transformed life, a life that is not conformed to that of the world. I strongly believe that no one can live a transformed life without a renewed mind.

Transformation starts from the mind. The only way you and I can recognise the perfect will of God for our lives is to have a renewed mind.

The reason why many people still remain in the same state of defeat even after becoming believers is because they do not have a renewed mindset. They still live in their past, they set aside the grace and love of God for their lives. Transformed believers instead will embrace and cherish the will of God as the best way and the highest form of life for them. However, without a renewed mind you will remain in the same state of defeat, uncertainty, failure and fear.

Acts 3:2-5

2 Now a man who was lame from birth was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put every day to beg from those going into the temple courts. 3 When he saw Peter and John about to enter, he asked them for money. 4 Peter looked straight at him, as did John. Then Peter said, "Look at us!" 5 So the man gave them his attention, expecting to get something from them.

Peter and John one afternoon met with a man who for over forty years sat at a place called the beautiful gate, yet for him nothing was beautiful. He was crippled from birth and had to be carried everyday to beg for alms. This man was known by everyone who came to the temple. He was crippled, hopeless and in a state of defeat and probably despair.

On this faithful day when he met with Peter and John something happened in this man's life that changed his life forever

The Bible says the man was expectant. What was he expecting? He probably was expecting money from Peter and John but there was an expectation of something good.

Peter and John were not going to give him what everyone else had always given to him. They were going to give him something completely different something that would bring a transformation to his life forever.

Yet it required a mind that would be renewed. You can never receive what God has for you if you do not have a renewed mind.

Unlike everyone else Peter and John did not give him money but they gave him four words that transformed his life but he had to receive those words. "RISE UP AND WALK"

6 Then Peter said, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk."

To arise is a word from the Lord for us this year.

The word ARISE means to

Get up or stand up, rise, get to one's feet, jump up, leap up, spring up · become erect, straighten up.

Many who met with Jesus were commanded to arise and do something that they probably could not do before.

How expectant are you today? Are you at that point in your life where you have lost all hope, where there is no more expectation? You have come to a cross road and you are wondering what is it all about, this Christianity thing.

To arise requires a renewed mind, a decision and determination to arise from what ever situation or circumstance you have found yourself in. It is a determination to change your position or see your position changed.

Many have remained in the same position for years without hope, many have allowed their position of affliction to define their lives.

I am here to challenge you today to have a renewed mind and arise and get up from your position of hopelessness.

Arise from your position of affliction.

Arise from the position of fear.

Transformation starts from your mind. You then go on to believe God for the impossible, obey His command to arise which leads to you walking in His perfect will for your life.

The lame man began to leap and praise God and people were amazed for they had known him to be the man who sat at the beautiful gate begging alms for over 40 years. He could have closed his mind to the words of Peter and John when they said to him, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk." Instead he opened his mind, heard their word and responded to it. When we have a renewed mind, we will live a transformed life in Christ. We will be able to test and prove and affirm the good will of God for our lives.

Youth Corner

This month we are looking at a question you as a Young Person or any of your friends might ask.

Question:

Has Science disproved the Bible or God? Do Science and the Bible go together?



Answer:

The Bible and true science are not against each other. There is much science that directly supports the Bible. Nor has science disproved the Bible or disproved that there is a God! Some people say this or think this. But this is not true at all. Science cannot prove there is no God. Amazingly there is one area of physics (quantum physics) which actually proves many things the Bible says. But we won't talk about that here!!

It's also important to remember that most science isn't against the Bible or about the Bible. Most scientists are working hard to search for evidence, truth and to do their jobs with excellence. Most of science is doing a great job. But this is about science that wants to try to disprove God or the Bible.

First of all, be aware that much of science and other professions don't have the Bible as their start point. Some scientists have even said that they will never accept that there is a God or that the Bible is true and will do anything to say that it is not true!! In other words, some people are so opposed to the Bible that they will never accept it is true and won't even be scientific about it.

Normally science takes evidence and then decides what conclusions come from the evidence. But when it comes to science and the Bible, things are often different. You see, people decide what to believe because of their start point. So if I believe that there is no God, then I will look at evidence and make my decisions from what I believe, often to support what I believe. But if I do believe in God then I what I believe will be seen with this kind of perspective. So you may have two people with the same evidence but they will say opposite things... Not because the evidence is not there or because it's different. Instead it's because they have different ideas and different beliefs. Many times when people say the Bible opposes science, they say this because their belief is already that there is no God. And in many nations, if you stand up as a scientist and say you believe the Bible, you will lose funding, lose support and often lose your job. We also live in a world of many so-called experts. Just because they are called experts doesn't mean they are and doesn't mean what they believe is right! And when it comes to the creation of the earth, some scientists try to use 'historical' science (that means science we can't evidence because it's in the past) rather than science that has proper evidence.

If people looked at the Bible without bias, they would find that time after time the Bible is completely accurate. Science cannot answer every question - it can only answer science questions. Science is also wrong at times because of people's beliefs, their agendas, their desire for funding etc. Science also often disagrees with itself - the same evidence producing different conclusions. People claim that sci-

ence is always based on evidence and the search for truth and that the Bible is not. But this is completely untrue. Discovery after discovery have proved the Bible's claims - in archaeology, in documents discovered and even in science. The Bible and science are not opposed to each other. They are different at times but it is amazing how often people look at science or at the creation or the universe and say it was a chance. But for our world to exist as it does so perfectly and in such a balance, the chances of that happening are so impossible that it is beyond science's own definition of what is impossible.

The Bible tells us that the devil has blocked people's minds against God and that there are people who want to take away your belief in God. If you don't believe this, then ask yourself when you last saw programmes that say the Bible is true or that tell you about the tens of thousands of discoveries that confirm the Bible. Instead, you see people who doubt the Bible making programmes that doubt the evidence mostly. So, we can understand why people around, science and scientists sometimes seem to be against the Bible. But there are hundreds of thousands of Christian scientists all around the world who believe in God, believe in the Bible and are brilliant at their jobs!

So next time someone tells you something that is supposed to prove there is no God or that the Bible isn't true, ask yourself some questions... First, where is this person coming from in terms of what they believe? Second, what is the starting point of how they interpret the evidence? Thirdly, are you being given the complete picture? Fourth, are they applying real science to what they say? Fifth and most important - what does God say? He is the one who created the world and the only one who was there at the beginning of the earth and universe! God created the materials that made the world - something that science cannot do. God and the Bible are completely true and perfect. Science never will be.

We also have to be careful of people who argue against what they say the Bible
