



Safeguarding

Safeguarding is a term used to denote measures to protect the health, well being and human rights of individuals which allow people, especially children, young people and vulnerable adults to live free from abuse, harm and neglect.

Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility. No single person can have a full picture of the needs or circumstances of a child, young person or vulnerable adult. And it is our biblical mandate to 'Speak out on behalf of the voiceless, and for the rights of all who are vulnerable. 'Proverbs 31:8

To this end, we have an appointed Safeguarding Coordinator and a Deputy Safeguarding Coordinator who are the first port of call and are responsible for ensuring the coordination of any concerns about a child, young person or vulnerable adult, or the behaviour of an adult working with vulnerable groups. The Safeguarding Coordinators are expected to work closely and confidentially with the church and to follow the church safeguarding policies to advice, inform, report and discuss any concerns that an individual may have about a child, young person or vulnerable adult.

The Safeguarding Coordinators will liaise with the relevant statutory authorities if and when necessary.

SCRIPTURAL PRAYER FOR THE MONTH

Our Father, today, we praise You with our whole heart. We will tell of all Your marvellous works. We will be glad and rejoice in You; we will sing praises to Your Name. We cry out with a loud voice, "Thanks be to our God." As the heavens are high above the earth, so great is Your mercy toward those who fear You; as far as the east is from the west, You have removed our transgressions from us. Father, You have asked us to continue to love one another, for love comes from You. Anyone who loves is Your child and knows You. Those who do not love do not know You, for You are love. THE GREATEST COMMANDMENT—TO LOVE—PART 1

Matthew 22: 36 - 40

36 "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the law?"

37 Jesus said to him, "'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and great commandment. 39 And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbour as yourself.' 40 On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets."

Mark 12: 28 - 34

28 Then one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, [a]perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him, "Which is the [b]first commandment of all?" 29 Jesus answered him, "The [c]first of all the commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. 30 And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' [d]This is the first commandment. 31 And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbour as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

32 So the scribe said to Him, "Well said, Teacher. You have spoken the truth, for there is one God, and there is no other but He. 33 And to love Him with all the heart, with all the understanding, [e]with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love one's neighbour as oneself, is more than all the whole burnt offerings and sacrifices."

34 Now when Jesus saw that he answered wisely, He said to him, "You are not far from the kingdom of God." But after that no one dared question Him.

God is love and love is from God.

God first loved us and continues to love us. In response He calls us in return to love too like He loves. To love Him first with all our hearts, soul and mind, and then to love our neighbours, other human beings as ourselves.

The First

The first of the greatest commandment is to love God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. This is about loving God with our whole Spirit, Soul and Body. Let's examine these four areas:

Our heart:

Our heart is the centre of our lives as people. It consists of both the Spirit and the Soul. God wants us to love Him with our spirit. When we become born again believers, he puts His love in our hearts (our spirit) by the Holy Spirit. God wants us to continue to love Him and grow in that love Him for Him, by allowing the Holy Spirit that in us when we become born again, to rule and reign supreme. He wants us to love him through allowing the Holy Spirit to speak to us, lead us, and guide us and cause the spirit man in us to have the upper hand and dominate the soul and the body.

Our Soul:

 Our soul consists of the mind, emotions and will. God calls us to love Him with our mind, in our thought life. He wants us to love Him with our feelings and

affections. He wants our feelings for Him to be that of unconditional love. He wants us to set our affection on Him. He wants us to love Him with our wills by choosing to make the right decisions that will please Him and glorify His name.

Our mind:

 Our mind consists of our thinking and intellectual process. God calls us to love Him through the thoughts we think about Him. He wants us to have the right mindset and thoughts about Him

Our Strength:

 Our strength refers to our physical strength. God wants us to love by using our bodies to glorify Him. By using our physical energy, skills, abilities, giftings to do His work and build His Kingdom

So, this commandment is about loving God wholeheartedly, with everything that we have and that we are. It is about putting God first and foremost in our lives. Making Him the centre of our lives and beings. This love is treasuring, admiring, delighting in, being crazy about God above all things, as the greatest treasure of our lives. The nature of this love is that which says like the Apostle Paul: "I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ my Lord" – Philippians 3: 8

How do we express or live out this love for God?

1. By obeying His commandments

John 14: 15

15 "If you love Me, [d]keep My commandments.

John 14: 21

21 He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

1 John 5: 2 – 3

2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God and keep His commandments. 3 For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome.

2. By keeping His Word

1 John 2: 5

5 But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God [a]is perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him.

3. By worshipping Him

John 4: 21 - 24

21 Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father. 22 You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews. 23 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. 24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

4. By being in His presence and sitting at His feet Luke 10: 38 - 42

38 Now it happened as they went that He entered a certain village; and a certain woman named Martha welcomed Him into her house. 39 And she had a sister called Mary, who also sat at [k]Jesus' feet and heard His word. 40 But Martha was distracted with much serving, and she approached Him and said, "Lord, do You not care that my sister has left me to serve alone? Therefore tell her to help me." 41 And [I]Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. 42 But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her."

 By loving Him more than our natural family – Father, Mother, Son, Daughter, Wife. Brother and Sister

Matthew 10: 37

37 He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me.

Luke 14: 26

26 "If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple.

6. By not loving the world or the things in the world

1 John 2: 15 – 17

15 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. 17 And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.

7. With our deeds and not just our words

1 John 3: 18

18 My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but indeed and in truth.

Mark 14: 3 – 9

And being in Bethany at the house of Simon the leper, as He sat at the table, a woman came having an alabaster flask of very costly [b]oil of spikenard. Then she broke the flask and poured it on His head. 4 But there were some who were indignant among themselves, and said, "Why was this fragrant oil wasted? 5 For it might have been sold for more than three hundred denarii and given to the poor." And they criticized her sharply. 6 But Jesus said, "Let her alone. Why do you trouble her? She has done a good work for Me. 7 For you have the poor with you always, and whenever you wish you may do them good; but Me you do not have always. 8 She has done what she could. She has come beforehand to anoint My body for burial. 9 Assuredly, I say to you, wherever this gospel is preached in the whole world, what this woman has done will also be told as a memorial to her."

In our strength we are not able to love God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. The Holy Spirit is there wanting to help us love God with our all. He is our helper. Let's turn to Him for grace to help us love the Lord the way he wants us to

The Bible says that God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, Jesus, so that whoever believes in him shall not die, but have eternal life (John 3: 16). GOD's Purpose: Peace and life God loves you and wants you to experience peace and life: abundant and eternal.

"we have peace with GOD through our Lord JESUS CHRIST." (Romans 5:1)

"I have come that they may have life in abundance." (John 10:10)



"for GOD so loved the world that he gave his only begotten SON, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

Why don't most people have this peace and abundant life that God planned for us to have?

The Problem: Our Separation God created us in his own image to have an abundant life. He did not make us as robots to automatically love and obey him. God gave us a will and a freedom of choice. We chose to disobey God and go our own wilful way. We still make this choice today. This results in separation from God.

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of GOD." (Romans 3:23) "for the wages of sin is death, but the gift of GOD is eternal life in CHRIST JESUS, our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

Our attempts to reach GOD People have tried many ways to bridge this gap between themselves and God....

"there is a way that seems right to man, but in the end it leads to death." (Proverbs 14:12) "but your iniquities have separated you from your GOD; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear." (Isaiah 59:2)

No bridge reaches GOD... except one...

GOD's Bridge: The Cross Jesus died on the cross and rose from the grave. He paid the penalty for our sin and bridged the gap between God and people.

for Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to GOD." (1 Peter 3:18)

"for there is one GOD and one mediator between GOD and men, that man JESUS CHRIST." (1 Timothy 2:5)

"but GOD demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, CHRIST died for us." (Romans 5:8)


Here is how you can receive Christ:
