







#### WORSHIP AT WORD OF LIFE CHURCH, REHOBOTH BUILDING WITH CONFI-DENCE

Rehoboth Building is OPEN for our regular Sunday and Wednesday services.

We have guidelines that prioritize your safety and align with the government's directives, in keeping Rehoboth Building open. We encourage you to continue to embrace these and work with us as we continue to fellowship and worship the Lord in person. Rehoboth Building is open to the whole WOL family, the community and the general public for services.

Below are:

- (1) Actions the CHURCH is taking to ensure your safety.
- (2) Actions required of YOU to ensure our collective safety.

#### What We Are Doing

- (1) Enforcing the requirement of registration to attend church services.
- (2) Check-in upon arrival, to aid contact tracing
- (3) Cleaning of shared areas and surfaces
- (4) Significantly Adjusted Seating to promote Physical distancing.
- (5) Physical Distancing and other Signs and Stickers posted in and out of the

building for your attention.

- (6) Slightly reduced length of singing time with a maximum of 2 singers and and1 instrumentalist at each service. Separate designated microphones are provided per each user (Singers and Speakers during each service)
- (7) Provision of individual packaged communion emblems for all
- (8) Personal Protective Equipment (disposable masks and gloves) provided for stewards
- (9) Hand Sanitiser stations placed at the Entry Point and Exit points. Hand sanitising is required for all upon entry and exit.
- (10) Still not able to join us in person due to having to self-isolate, sickness, old age or other reasons? Online services continue to hold.

#### What We Need from You

- (1) Please register all members in your family before attending in-person services and check-in at the check in point upon arrival. You will need to register via the church website at www.wordoflife-lcc.org for each service you wish to attend
- (2) Please use the hand sanitisers provided when entering the building and when exiting.
- (3) The stewards are there to help. Please strictly follow their instructions for your safety and the safety of others
- (4) Family members are required to please sit together. Parents, please plan to keep young children with you at all times (except during the time they go to the lower hall for the Children's church and youth cell)
- (5) Handshaking and hugging are strongly not allowed
- (6) Please use the main front doors for entry and for exit. The stewards will be on hand to help and guide you
- (7)
- Please come with, and wear a mask during your time in Rehoboth Building.
  Children under 11 do not have to have face masks on.
- (8) Refreshments (food and drink) will not be distributed at this time
- (9) If you need a drink during the service, please kindly come in with a bottle of water. This is not to be shared with others.
- (10) Please choose ONLINE giving and other non-cash methods where possible. If unable to do this, you can still give cash in during the in-person services at Rehoboth Building
- (11) We appreciate your patience and co-operation as we continue to navigate this new season.

In this season, we encourage you to continue to prioritise safety, and to choose faith over fear. It is been an unprecedented time in history, so if you are feeling mentally drained, you are not alone. God is with you and will never leave you nor forsake you. We also encourage you to speak to someone about how you are feeling. Speak to your cell leader, or deputy cell leader, or one of the other Word of Life leaders.

# FEATURE ARTICLE OF THE MONTH

#### LORD, GIVE ME TREASURES OUT OF DARKNESS!

Isaiah 45 v 3 I will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden riches of secret places.



Jer 33 v 3 Call to Me and I will answer and show you great and unsearchable things you do not know

Prov 25 v 2 It is the glory of God to conceal a matter and the glory of kings to search out a matter

Matt 11 v 25 At that time Jesus declared, "I praise you Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned and revealed them to little children.

I recently read a book explaining the events and history of how our bible came about. This book included a section on the Dead Sea Scrolls.....

Amazingly, in 1947 a 14 year old Bedouin shepherd boy was grazing his sheep and goats in an ancient Jewish settlement in Qumran, on the NW shore of the Dead Sea, now known as the West bank. One of his sheep wandered off and he left the others to go and look for it !! (sound familiar?) He came across a small opening of a cave and threw in a stone. He was amazed to hear a sound of shattering pottery. He went in to investigate and found stone jars containing rolls of parchment with old Hebrew writing. He had unwittingly found a great treasure that had been concealed in darkness for about 2000 years.

When archeologists later went in to investigate this find, they discovered 11 other caves in the area containing over 900 scrolls. These scrolls turned out to be the largest and the oldest copy of the Hebrew bible ever discovered to date, containing every book of the Old Testament (except the book of Esther). Carbon dating has shown that these scrolls were written between 200BC and AD70.

Apart from the amazing evidence for the accuracy and history of our bible, this true account got me wondering about the amazing and glorious ways of the Lord. He does nothing by accident, and chose to hide these treasures from the wise and learned and reveal them to a 'little child' who was looking for a lost sheep. It is believed that theses scrolls were written by an ancient Jewish Sect, who lived separate from the community, dedicating themselves to a holy life of separation to the Lord. It is thought the scrolls were either stored in these caves or hidden there during the Jewish Roman war of AD70, for protection. Can you imagine the excitement of archeologists who would have searched the whole of Israel to have found these scrolls? And yet they were hidden for an unknown shepherd boy, to find whilst absent mindedly throwing a stone into a cave!

# FEATURE ARTICLE OF THE MONTH

**Isaiah 45v3 says I will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden riches of secret places.** This scripture is part of a promise that the Lord gave to King Cyrus, who the Lord used to fulfil His promise to Israel, in that they would return to their promised land after a period of exile. It was common for Kings and conquers of lands, to loot the treasures taken in battle and store them in secret places for times of necessity. In this prophetic verse, the Lord is promising Cyrus that He is going to reveal the whereabouts of such treasures and give them to him.

The bible often gives us both a spiritual meaning and a literal meaning to the writing. There are spiritual treasures hidden for us to search out. Proverbs 25 v 2 says it is the glory of God to conceal a matter but the glory of kings is to search out a matter. The bible calls us 'kings and priests' (Rev 1 v 6). To be a king scripturally is to take governance and to rule; to take dominion in the spiritual realm, and therefore on the Earth, through the power of the Holy Spirit. What is the treasure that is hidden in darkness? It is spiritual, scriptural truths that display the glory of the Lord and therefore set us free! It is the wisdom that is hidden from the wise and learned and revealed to little children. It is supernatural revelation of what to do in a difficult situation, or information about the future that will help you or another make a good choice. It is healing for those who need it, and understanding of the ways of God. The bible invites us to approach the Lord boldly and ask Him for all manner of things (you have not because you ask not (James 4 v 2)). It is the glory of God to conceal a matter. Why does the Lord hide treasures from us? Have you ever given a £50 note to a child under 5 years old? Of course not, they would draw a picture on it or cut it up to make a pretty pattern. They would not understand the value of a £50 note and therefore it would be worthless in their hands. The Lord conceals His treasures because He wants us to seek for them. We don't seek for anything unless it is valuable to us. When we seek the Lord in prayer, fasting and reading the bible, we show Him we are hungry to know Him. It is our glory as spiritual kings to seek the Lord and to find Him. When the Lord gives us a revelation, we feel like we are the only person on Earth who could possibly know such a precious truth. We value it and go back for more revelation. Ask of me and I will tell you deep and hidden things you do not know (Jer 33 v 3).

There are bound to be more physical treasures hidden in secret places across the world, either buried, hidden in caves, in the sea, maybe under our feet, or in our back garden! The Lord knows exactly where they are! Treasures that make us wonder at the Lord's glory and reveal more secrets!

So what about the 14 year old shepherd boy looking for his sheep? Was it a mistake that the Lord chose to reveal this treasure to a child? Of course not. The Lord speaks to us through many circumstances. The 'wise and learned' the bible refers to are those who are clever by their own standards, and therefore not able to humble themselves to receive simple yet profound truth from God the Father. The bible tells us to come as a little child. A little child finds it so easy to believe in Jesus. They trust this is the truth and do not debate.

# FEATURE ARTICLE OF THE MONTH

The shepherd boy was being a faithful shepherd when he went looking for his lost sheep (Luke 15v3-7). The value of his lost sheep was enough to cause him to leave the comfort of his group to go looking for the one that was lost. He was truly rewarded for the faithfulness to his cause.

According to an article entitled 'The Shepherd Who Found the Dead Sea Scrolls' on web site 'history-of-yesterday.com' the shepherd boy faded into obscurity. He was located again in 1952 when he was interviewed and photographed. He was reported to have remained in the area, continuing to shepherd and excavate! He is largely unknown and continued to live a simple life. He would be in his 70s now, possibly still not fully appreciating the value of the treasures he found in the darkness. Lord we pray you reveal yourself to this precious man. That he would understand the one who led him to the cave to unearth scrolls lovingly and carefully written and stored by your servants 2000BC. Let him know the true shepherd that gave Himself as a sacrificial lamb to save him from his sins. Amen.

### ..... EXHORTATION ...... The hands and feet of jesus

John 14:12 "Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes in me will also do the works that I do; and greater works than these will he do, because I am going to the Father.

A quote I picked up recently, this is what is says.

Being the hands and feet of Jesus means that Christ's followers, past, present, and future, are obedient in their commission to preach the gospel and co-labour with Christ to love, serve, and heal the broken, hurting, and hopeless of this world.



Thirty-two years ago, I gave my life to Christ, He became my Lord and my Saviour. The journey to my salvation began more than 32 years ago because there were people who preached the gospel to me, people who prayed for me, people who saw beyond my defensive mechanism, people who never stopped loving me despite my attitude towards them, they were the hands and feet of Jesus.

No other generation has spoken of the love of God as much as this generation, we sing and speak of how God loves us, yet this generation has been the least to demonstrate or share the love of Jesus to others.

The love of God is not a sentimental kind of love, it is the love that gave His only begotten son for the lives of sinners on the way to hell.

It is the love that nailed His beloved son to the cross.

#### John 3:16-17

16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. 17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

I am so shocked that many believers today focus more on their needs than what is on God's heart. I am not exempt, many of us have focussed on what is important to us and neglected God's heart.

We live in a world of tired, wearied, hopeless, fearful, morally and spiritually bankrupt people, looking for hope and truth.

Every Christian believer is meant to be an envoy of hope. Paul calls us ambassadors of Christ. We are not an embassy, we are ambassadors.

### ..... EXHORTATION Cntd......

An ambassador is an accredited diplomat sent by a state as its permanent representative in a foreign country. An embassy can be simply described as a diplomatic mission of a country represented in another country. Embassy can also refer to the official residence or offices of the ambassador. An ambassador acts as the official communication channel between the two countries.

Let us take a look at 2 Corinthians 5:20 20 Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.

We represent God's kingdom on this earth, we are God's communication line with the unsaved.

There is no good news out there; there may hot gossips, scandalous news, defamatory news, even reality shows but there is no good news.

#### Romans 10:14-15

14 How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? 15 And how shall they preach unless they are sent? As it is written:

"How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the gospel of peace, who bring glad tidings of good things!"

Beautiful feet preach Jesus, beautiful feet carry the gospel, beautiful feet bring people to the cross, beautiful feet bring hope to the hopeless, etc.

1 Corinthians 12:27 *Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it.* 

Jesus said to His disciple in the book of Mark 16:15-18 15 And He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature..... 16 He who believes and is baptized will they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

This is the time for us to now see things the way God sees it. There is no limitation to what God do if we truly or choose to become the hands and feet of Jesus in this land.

He is the one that gave us the authority, the anointing and the power to GO.

So let us become HIS HANDS AND HIS FEET

The Bible says that God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, Jesus, so that whoever believes in him shall not die, but have eternal life (John 3: 16).


