



WORSHIP AT WORD OF LIFE CHURCH, REHOBOTH BUILDING WITH CONFI-DENCE

We have guidelines that prioritize your safety and align with the government's and Elim directives, in keeping Rehoboth Building open. We encourage you to continue to embrace the changes and work with us as we continue to fellowship and worship

the Lord in this new season. Rehoboth Building is open to the whole WOL family, the community and the general public for services,

Below are:

- (1) Actions the CHURCH is taking to ensure your safety.
- (2) Actions required of YOU to ensure our collective safety.

What We Are Doing

- (1) Enforcing the requirement of registration to attend church services.
- (2) Check-in upon arrival, to aid contact tracing
- (3) Two services to allow for spaced-out gatherings. First service at 9.00am, second service at 11am
- (4) Cleaning of shared areas and surfaces between services
- (5) Training of all Stewards
- (6) Significantly Adjusted Seating to promote Physical distancing.
- (7) Physical Distancing and other Signs and Stickers posted in and out of the building for your attention.
- (8) Slightly reduced length of singing time with a maximum of 2 singers and and1 instrumentalist at each service. Separate designated microphones are provided per each user (Singers and Speakers during each service)
- (9) Provision of individual packaged communion emblems for all
- (10) Personal Protective Equipment (disposable masks and gloves) provided for stewards
- (11) Hand Sanitiser stations placed at the Entry Point and Exit points. Hand sanitising is required for all upon entry and exit.
- (12) Still not able to join us in person due to having to self-isolate, sickness, old age or other reasons? Online services continue to hold.

What We Need from You

- (1) Please register all members in your family before attending in-person services and check-in at the check in point upon arrival. You will need to register via the church website at www.wordoflife-lcc.org for each service you wish to attend
- (2) Please use the hand sanitisers provided when entering the building and when exiting.
- (3) The stewards are there to help. Please strictly follow their instructions for your safety and the safety of others
- (4) Family members are required to please sit together. Parents, please plan to keep young children with you at all times (except during the time they go to the lower hall for the Children's church and youth cell)
- (5) Handshaking and hugging are strongly not allowed
- (6) Please use the main front doors for entry and for exit. The stewards will be on hand to help and guide you
- (7) Please come with, and wear a mask during your time in Rehoboth Building. Children under 11 do not have to have face masks on.
- (8) Refreshments (food and drink) will not be distributed at this time.
- (9) If you need a drink during the service, please kindly come in with a bottle of

water. This is not to be shared with others.

- (10) Please choose ONLINE giving and other non-cash methods where possible. If unable to do this, you can still give cash in during the in-person services at Rehoboth Building
- (11) We appreciate your patience as we continue to navigate this new season

In this season, we encourage you to continue to prioritise safety, and to choose faith over fear. It is been an unprecedented time in history, so if you are feeling mentally drained, you are not alone. God is with you and will never leave you nor forsake you. We also encourage you to speak to someone about how you are feeling. Speak to your cell leader, or deputy cell leader, or one of the other Word of Life leaders.


We love you and look forward to having you back in Word of Life Church Rehoboth Building in-person, if you haven't returned already!

♦ INTRODUCING GIVT

Word of Life Church now uses **Givt** as an additional way of giving tithes & offerings. Givt is an app that allows you to participate in the giving to the work of Word of Life Church anytime and anywhere. Whether you are watching the service from home, or have no cash with you during church service. With Givt you can just keep giving. Open the app, choose how much you want to give, choose how you want to give and you're done!





You're ready to give. Scan this QR code with the Givt app.



Giving with Givt via a QR code works as follows:

1. During the Offering time, open the Givt app, as usual

2. Choose the amount you want to give and press next


3. Then choose the second option in your screen: QR code (enter by means of a QR code)

4. Scan the QR code with your camera (Note! The app may request permission to access your camera. Press OK to continue)

5. Finally, press Next to complete the gift

Giving without a QR code or transmitter nearby?

2. Choose the amount you want to give.

(Are there multiple collections in a service? No problem! To add a collection, press the plus key at add collection and enter the amount you want to give to the 2nd collection. Add another third collection? Then press the plus and choose your amount for the third collection.)

- 3. Then choose the third option, give from the List
- 4. Enter the name or place of your church in the search bar

5. Select **Word of Life Church (Lewisham)** as the church you want to give to and tap on give at the bottom of your screen

6. Finally, press Next to complete the gift.

- > **The ease of giving-** with Give you are able to give with **one smooth gesture** and you decide how much you want to give. Easy and fast, you're in control.
- Giving is anonymous- A donation with Givt cannot be traced back to a person by our church. Word of Life Church receives the total amount donated in its bank account and not as separate donations. This means that giving with Givt is just a s anonymous as giving cash.
- Gift Aid with the flick of a switch- Adding Gift Aid to your donations is so simple and doesn't involve extensive paperwork. After you enter your details the first time, you simply switch on Gift Aid in the app, and that's it. Now Gift Aid is enabled for Word of Life Church. Hassle-free Gift Aid, which is better for everyone!
- Free & one-time registration Givt can be downloaded for free on the App Store and on Google Play. Create a user account by entering your information just once.
- No internet connection required- when using the Givt app, you don't need an active internet connection at the time of giving. At a later time, for example when you're at home and using WiFi, your donation will be sent. No action required by you.

..... EXHORTATION

DOING THE UNTHINKABLE

By Reverend Rowland Henshaw

1 Samuel 14:1

This chapter of the bible emphasizes the victory of the Israelites over the Philistines but the story itself starts with a young man who had the faith and courage to do the unthinkable.

This is the history of a group of discouraged, frustrated, outnumbered and inadequately armed soldiers. With no hope of victory, no hope of escape. Their leader King Saul has run out of ideas and in hiding.

Yet the bible says in verse 23 of chapter 14 ... 23 So the Lord saved Israel that day, and the battle shifted to Beth Aven.

What happened? What was it that changed their situation?

It was faith, the daring faith of a young man who dared to trust and believe that God can do the impossible.

The lord saved Israel on that day because Jonathan the son of Saul did the unthinkable.

In 1 Samuel 14:1 we read that on

<u>14 1 One day Jonathan son of Saul said to his young armor-bearer, "Come, let's go over to the Philistine outpost on the other side." But he did not tell his father.</u>

It is interesting that Jonathan did not tell his father what he was about to do. He did not tell any of the other soldiers his plans.

Why? Everyone would have thought what he was about to do was reckless and mad. I can just imagine his armor bearer saying to himself, "this is suicidal but I have no choice". "He is the King's son and as an armor bearer I have no choice but to follow him".

<u>6 Then Jonathan said to the young man who bore his armor, "Come, let us go</u> <u>over to the garrison of these uncircumcised; it may be that the Lord will work for</u> <u>us. For nothing restrains the Lord from saving by many or by few."</u>

When our faith propels us to do the unthinkable it is best to keep it to ourselves, just go ahead and do it.

Daring faith looks beyond what it sees

Daring faith listens beyond what it hears

Daring faith casts out fear and doubt before it acts.

Jonathan had to trust God and believe that God was the only one who could help him, it did not really matter how many soldiers he had, he knew God was going to do the impossible through him and his armourbearer.

Jonathan and his armor bearer were taking on a whole garrison of Philistines.

His trust was not in his ability to fight.

His trust was not in His weapon.

His trust was not in who his father was.

His trust was in the God who rules in the affairs of men.

His trust was God who could save with many or with little.

He trusted God.

He believed that God was able to do what man cannot do.

..... EXHORTATION Cntd.....

In Mark 9: 23 "'If you can'?" said Jesus. "Everything is possible for one who believes."

To those who believe all things are possible.

As long as you are a believer you can do the impossible, you can do daring things.

The key is in believing that Jesus' promise is yes and amen.

Many believers have lost heart and failed in their quest for victory because they failed to trust the Word of Jesus that "*Everything is possible for one who believes.*"

Israel had been under the siege and oppression of the philistines for years, the Philistines had terrorized Israel, deprived them of freedom. Yet Saul and his soldiers remained in fear.

The Philistines were many and there was only Jonathan and his armourbearer. Scripture says in 1 Samuel 14:13-15

13 And Jonathan climbed up on his hands and knees with his armorbearer after him; and they fell before Jonathan. And as he came after him, his armorbearer killed them. 14 That first slaughter which Jonathan and his armorbearer made was about twenty men within about half an acre of land.

15 And there was trembling in the camp, in the field, and among all the people. The garrison and the raiders also trembled; and the earth quaked, so that it was a very great trembling

God helped Jonathan and his armourbearer to defeat the Philistines because Jonathan had a daring faith.

You can today gain victory for yourself

You can gain restoration.

You can gain your territory back.

God is waiting for you to make a bold move just like Jonathan and his armourbearer. God wants you to trust Him so He can fight for you.

1 John 5:4-5

4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world our faith. 5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?

You are born of God you and you are an overcomer.

You are a believer.

Do something daring today.

Bless someone today

Pray and believe God for someone's healing today.

Praise God aloud today.

Give something today.

Just do something that you have never done before and dare yourself. To him who believes all things are possible.

....GOD LOVES YOU

God Loves YOU and wants you to have a relationship with Him through His son Jesus.

The Bible says that God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, Jesus, so that whoever believes in him shall not die, but have eternal life (John 3: 16).

The first step to know more of God is to obey His Word and receive Jesus as your Lord and Saviour, by simply repenting of your sins and believing that Jesus has died on the cross and paid the price for you to be reconciled to God for ever. By doing that, you will receive a new life, the very life of God, within you, and you will become a child of God. If you want to make that step, please see below. 
