



His call is to stir hearts to prayer, practically inspire the Church to outreach & to activate a radical move of the Holy Spirit which will facilitate revival. He has been involved in the training & development of local and international missions teams in over

30 countries spanning three continents. Kristian is an Advisory Evangelist based at Capstone church in the UK where he encourages UK Churches towards radical mission and to establish new expressions of church in different towns & cities. In his spare time, Kristian loves playing football, swimming, hanging with his family & researching the history of great revivals & revivalists.







EXHORTATION

TAKING BACK TERRITORY

By Reverend Rowland Henshaw

This month we are taking back our territory.

We are taking back the territory based on the authority given to us by Jesus.

He says in Matthew 28:19

18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them

to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.



Immediately after Jesus had said to His disciples "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth".

The following word spoken by Jesus was "GO". This is not a suggestion; it is a command. A command to move, proceed, progress, advance, declare God's kingdom and take back all that the enemy has stolen from us. Not in fear but in power and authority.

For years many Christians or believers have missed or misconstrued this word. I believe that just as God in the garden of Eden blessed Adam and commanded him in **Genesis 1:28**

Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

Our place as victorious believers is to advance the kingdom of God and see changes and transformation in our society, community, our homes, schools, government, etc.

We know that the only thing the enemy is good at, is destroying and disrupting lives, but Jesus has given us the authority to take back all that the enemy has stolen.

Jesus says in John 10:10

10 The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

For years the enemy has stolen, destroyed lives, killed, maimed, and deprived many of their health, finances, joy and many more.

Isaiah 62:1

For Zion's sake I will not hold My peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her salvation as a lamp that burns.

To keep silent is to accept the situation. When you keep silent you are walking in

unbelief, you agree with the devil that your situation is acceptable.

Keeping quiet should not be the narrative for any believer, Jesus says **all authority has** been given to me on heaven and on earth, Go.

The word of God is in your mouth to uproot, destroy every assignment of the enemy concerning your life and your families.

When David came to the battlefield, he observed how goliath was taunting the children of Israel, everyone he saw was afraid and spoke in whispers. The enemy called Goliath was gloating, shouting abuses and insults at the Israelites.

1 Samuel 17:16

16 And the Philistine drew near and presented himself forty days, morning, and evening.

The bible says Goliath gloated and goaded the Israelites for 40 days, morning and night.

Saul and the Israelites did nothing but cower everyday that Goliath presented himself.

Are you like the Israelite Soldiers cowering, hiding and trembling, with discouragement, loss of strength, of focus, loss of loved ones, loss of faith, etc, because of the barrage of the enemy's taunts and torments.

The bible tells us that one day David went out to visit his brothers on the battlefield and heard Goliath's reproach and was provoked by this insult.

1 Samuel 17:26

26 Then David spoke to the men who stood by him, saying, "What shall be done for the man who kills this Philistine and takes away the reproach from Israel? For who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?"

Today and always, you can take a stance against discouragement, fear, sickness, etc. and take possession of your territory today.

In Acts 10:38, Peter described Jesus as one who "went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil."

David challenged Goliath, he refused to be intimidated by his family, Goliath, or anyone because his trust was in God and not in his strength.

1 Samuel 17: 41-47

41 So the Philistine came, and began drawing near to David, and the man who bore the shield went before him. 42 And when the Philistine looked about and saw David, he disdained him; for he was only a youth, ruddy and good-looking. 43 So the Philistine said to David, "Am I a dog, that you come to me with sticks?" And the Philistine cursed David by his gods. 44 And the Philistine said to David, "Come to me, and I will give your flesh to the birds of the air and the beasts of the field!"

45 Then David said to the Philistine, "You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. 46 This day the Lord will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you and take your head from you. And this day I will give the carcasses of the camp of the Philistines to the birds of the air and the wild beasts of the earth, that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel. 47 Then all this assembly shall know that the Lord does not save with sword and spear; for the battle is the Lord's, and He will give you into our hands."

As His ambassadors, we can speak with His authority as we share His Word, as we cry out to Him in prayer, as we walk with Him. We begin to take territories, we repair broken breaches, we establish God's kingdom in our communities, our homes, etc.

2 Corinthians 10:3-6

3 For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. 4 For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, 5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ, 6 and being ready to punish all disobedience when your obedience is fulfilled.

Walking in this authority, means that we also walk in obedience to the authority of God.

We take possession of our territory because we are the children of God

John 1:12

12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

Walking in this authority also means we can approach God's throne of grace with confidence.

Hebrews 4:16

16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Taking back our possession is acknowledging that without God we are nothing and that our boast is in the Lord.

2 Corinthians 10:9.

8 For even if I should boast somewhat more about our authority, which the Lord gave us for edification and not for your destruction, I shall not be ashamed.

2 Corinthians 10:17

17 But "he who glories, let him glory in the Lord." 18 For not he who commends himself is approved, but whom the Lord commends.

The authority we have as believers comes from God. We can do nothing of our own. This month take back that which belongs to you, your family, your children, your community. Do not give up, stand your grounds having put on the whole armour of God. (Ephesians 6:10-18)

..... GOD LOVES YOU

God Loves YOU and wants you to have a relationship with Him through His son Jesus.

The Bible says that God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, Jesus, so that whoever believes in him shall not die, but have eternal life (John 3: 16).

The first step to know more of God is to obey His Word and receive Jesus as your Lord and Saviour, by simply repenting of your sins and believing that Jesus has died on the cross and paid the price for you to be reconciled to God for ever. By doing that, you will receive a new life, the very life of God, within you, and you will become a child of God. If you want to make that step, please see below. These will explain to you more about it. Don't put it off, God has been waiting for you... Today is the day! God bless you.

GOD LOVES YOU!!!)

GOD's Purpose: Peace and life God loves you and wants you to experience peace and life: abundant and eternal.

"we have peace with GOD through our Lord JESUS CHRIST." (Romans 5:1)

"I have come that they may have life in abundance." (John 10:10)



"for GOD so loved the world that he gave his only begotten SON, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

Why don't most people have this peace and abundant life that God planned for us to have?

The Problem: Our Separation God created us in his own image to have an abundant life. He did not make us as robots to automatically love and obey him. God gave us a will and a freedom of choice. We chose to disobey God and go our own wilful way. We still make this choice today. This results in separation from God.

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of GOD." (Romans 3:23) "for the wages of sin is death, but the gift of GOD is eternal life in CHRIST JESUS, our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

Our attempts to reach GOD People have tried many ways to bridge this gap between themselves and God....

"there is a way that seems right to man, but in the end it leads to death." (Proverbs 14:12) "but your iniquities have separated you from your GOD; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear."
(Isaiah 59:2)

No bridge reaches GOD... except one...

GOD's Bridge: The Cross Jesus died on the cross and rose from the grave. He paid the penalty for our sin and bridged the gap between God and people.

for Christ died for sins once for all, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring GOD and men, that man you to GOD." (1 Peter 3:18)

"for there is one GOD and one mediator between JESUS CHRIST." (1 Timothy 2:5)

"but GOD demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, CHRIST died (Romans 5:8)

GOD has provided the only way. Each person must make a choice!



Our Response: Receive CHRIST We must trust Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour and receive him by personal invitation.

"yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name. he gave the right to become children of GOD." (John 1:12)

"here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and from the dead, you he with me." (Revelation 3:20)
